NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the County Court of the County of Union, Oregon, will on the 8th day of September , 1966, at the County Court Room at La Grande, Oregon, at the hour of 10 o'clock in the forenoon consider the report of the County Road Master of Union County made upon his examination in the matter of the proposed vacation of portions of road No 563, also known as county road No 73, described as follows:

Commencing at a point near the corner of Section 4, T6S, R39, EWM, said point being at the intersection of the north side of said road and the east side of said road, running thence north a distance of 2600 feet, more or less, to a point due east of the south side of Lamkin road which runs east and west; said description being the east side or a portion of county road No 563, also known as Road No 73 the center of which is 30 feet west thereof; also beginning at a point 2105.1 ft south of the north west section corner of Section 4, T6SR39EWM, said point being at the center line of said county road No 563, running thence north to a point where county road No 273 intersects No 563, thence along the center line of No 273 to a point where said No 273 is crossed by Highway No 30; and the record owners of real property immediately adjacent thereto are Glenn L. Pratt and Marian E Pratt, Susan W Lampkin and the State of Oregon,




WHEREAS, it appears to the County Court of Union County, Oregon, that portions of county road No 563, also known as road No 73 as renumbered for convenience of the county court and the road department, more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

Commencing at a point near the corner of Section 4, 6S, R39, EWM, said point being at the intersection of the north side of said road and the east side of said road, running thence north a distance of 2600 feet, more or less, to a point due east of the south side of Lamkin road which runs east and west; said description being the east side or a portion of County Road No 563, also known as Road No 73 the center of which is 30 feet west thereof; also beginning at a point 2105.1 ft south of the North West Section corner of Section 4, T6SR39EWM, said point being at the center line of said County Road No 563, running thence north to a point where county road No 273 intersects No 563, thence along the center line of No 273 to a point where said No 273 is crossed by Highway No 30; and the record owners of real property immediately adjacent there to are Glenn I Pratt and Marian E Pratt, and Susan W Lampkin, and said portions of said roads are useless as a part of the general road system of Union County and have not been used by the public as a part of the general road system of Union County; and would therefor now be burdensome to maintain.

WHEREAS, said portions of said roads No 563, also known as No 73, and No 273 are no longer in use by the public, and the public will be benefited by the vacation of said portions of said roads;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that such proceedings as are required by law generally, and ORS 368.565, et. seq. specifically, to vacate said described portions of said roads will be undertaken.


