WHEREAS, The County Court did have hearings and posted notices on said petitioned road and,


WHEREAS, The County Court and the majority of the people attending the hearings find it advisable to keep the road open,


WHEREAS, it appearing to the County Court that it is in the best interest of the public to retain subject road for ready access.


THEREFORE: COUNTY ROAD #11 (originally #525) also known as Bushnell Lane will remain open as part of the County Road System.
