

FINDINGS OF FACT

The County Court finds that the said County Road is burdensome to maintain. Therefore it will be classed as a public use road and not maintained from the most westerly point of description easterly to terminus of description.

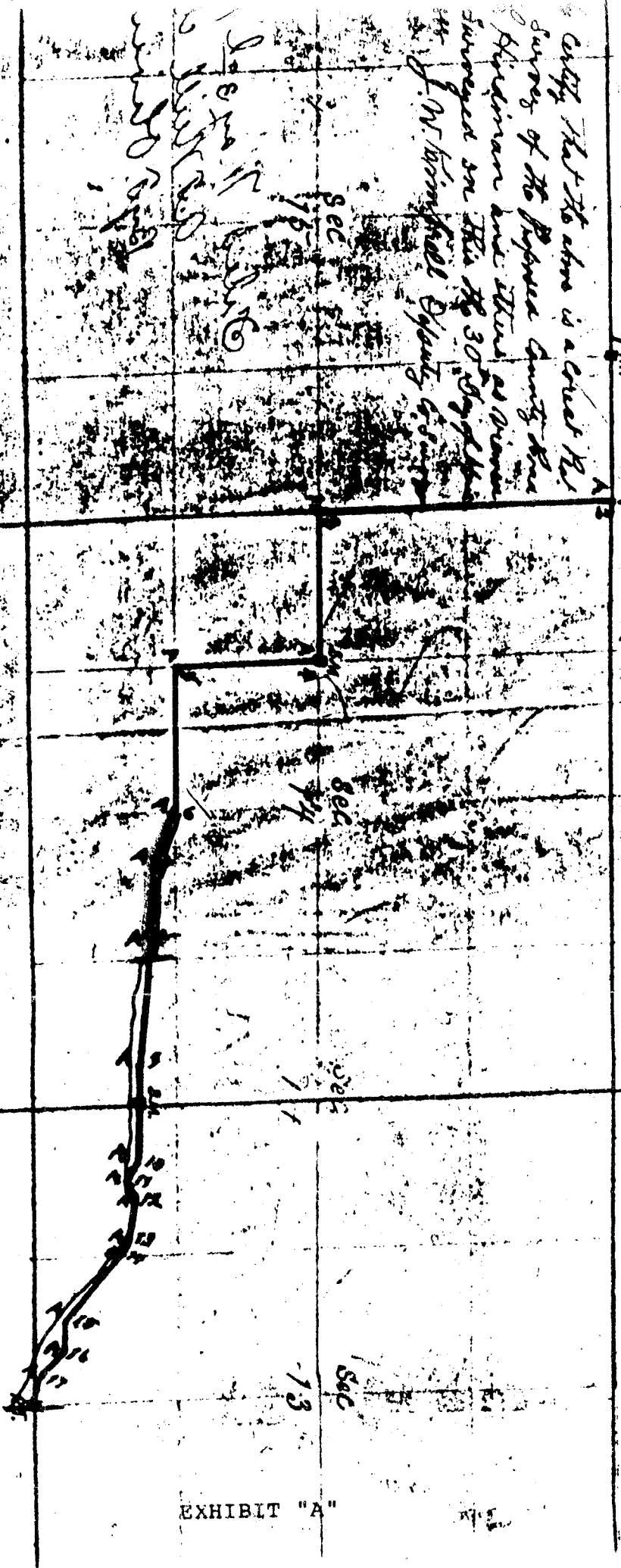
