WHEREAS, the Union County Court meeting in special session December 16, 1981, did hold a public hearing to consider the vacation of a portion of County Road No. 622, beginning approximately 5.75 miles southwest of the City of Union at a point at the common corners of Sections 23, 24, 25, & 26, Twp. 5S, Range 39 EWM, and running in an easterly direction to its terminus with La Grande/North Powder Highway No. 237 at a point in the southeast quarter of the southwest quarter of Section 20, Twp. 5S, Range 40 EWM, located in Union County, Oregon; and

WHEREAS, approximately 6,500 feet of County Road No. 622 from the point of beginning approximately 6.75 miles southwest of the City of Union at a point on Jimmy Creek Road, County Road No. 72, to common corners of Sections 23, 24, 25, & 26, Twp. 5S, Range 39 EWM, will remain a County Road.

WHEREAS, County Road No. 622 is not now used as a part of the County Road System, is useless as a part of the general road system, dangerous and an unnecessary maintenance burden upon the County and the public, and the County would be benefitted by its vacation to adjacent landowners; and




WHEREAS, the County Court, on its own motion, desires to vacate a portion of said County Road No. 622.

WHEREAS, the adjacent landowners were notified and the notice was posted in three public places in the vicinity of the said road; and

WHEREAS, the public would be benefitted by the vacation of the road;

NOW THEREFORE, the Union County Court HEREBY vacates a portion of County Road No. 622 described as beginning at a point at the common corners of the Sections 23, 24, 25 & 26 to the terminus with La Grande/North Powder Highway No. 237 at a point in the southeast quarter of the southwest quarter of Section 20, Twp. 5S, Range 40 EWM, located in Union County, Oregon.
