


WHEREAS, this matter has come before the County Court for hearing on Wednesday the 2nd day of April, 1986, for the vacation of a portion of dedicated street in Alicel, Union County, Oregon, and it appearing to the Court that a petition was filed with the County Planning Department thirty days prior to the hearing and that property notice of the pendency of the petition has been given as required under ORS 271.010;


NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the portions of Fifth, Sixth, and Depot Streets in the Alicel area, which have not been opened or used by the public for a period of 20-years, of the following described property be vacated:

A portion of a dedicated public street in the Alicel Subdivision, Twp. 2S, Range 39 EWM, Section 7DA, more specifically described as that portion of Fifth Street 80 feet in width between Blocks 19 and 20, approximately 250 feet in length; that portion of Sixth Street 80 feet in width between Blocks 18 and 19, approximately 250 feet in length; and that portion of Depot Street 80 feet in width between Blocks 19 and 30 and Fifth and Sixth Streets, approximately 380 feet in length.
