WHEREAS, Union County has processed the Glass Hill Road legalization according to ORS 368.201 through 368.426;

WHEREAS, historical survey records (1933) for the south six miles (beginning at Twp. 4S, Range 38 EWM, Section 5, North line of Lot 4) are incomplete;

WHEREAS, the Union County Board of Commissioners received a petition signed by 208 people requesting the County to pursue legalization proceedings;

WHEREAS, the Union County Board of Commissioners notified abutting landowners, posted in three locations and advertised in The Observer a public hearing on March 20, 1991, 10:00 a.m to accept testimony and potentially make a decision to "legalize" the south approximately six miles of Glass Hill Road, County Road No. 6;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE UNION COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, STATE OF OREGON:

SECTION 1: ROAD LEGALIZATION

The described property assigned Survey No. 013-1991 and 014-1991 to be recorded when the final pins are set is legalized and recognized as a part of County Road No. 6.
