WHEREAS, Union County finds part of 12th Street entirely within La Grande city limits due to annexation on April 17, 1992, 1992;

WHEREAS, ORS 373.270 establishes the procedures for transferring jurisdiction over county roads within cities;

WHEREAS, public notice was published in "The Observer" on August 6, 13, 20 & 27, 1992 advertising a public hearing on the proposed transfer; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COURT OF THE COUNTY OF UNION, STATE OF OREGON:

SECTION 1: TRANSFERRING JURISDICTION OF A PORTION OF 12TH STREET TO THE CITY OF LA GRANDE

The Union County Board of Commissioners hereby offers to the City of La Grande to surrender jurisdiction over a portion of 12th Street described as follows:

the north right-of-way line from Taurus Avenue south 846 feet.

SECTION 2: TIME FOR ACCEPTANCE

The offer described in Section 1 is valid for six (6) months to provide the City of La Grande adequate time to complete the adoption process; at the end of such time if the offer is not accepted and the roads or parts thereof are not adopted in the city street system the offer will expire.
