WHEREAS, Union County received an application on August 28, 1995, requesting a roadway to be named Heritage Lane;

WHEREAS, Union County Ordinance No. 1988-3 Section 1.200 requires the County Board of Commissioners to provide public hearing notice to adjoining landowners and in the newspaper;

WHEREAS, landowners adjacent to the affected roadway were mailed notice of a public hearing;

SECTION 1: ROAD NAME ADOPTION

A private road named Heritage Lane extending east of Conklin Road beginning in Twp. 3S, Range 40 EWM, SE quarter, SW quarter of Section 15, more particularly described as the southwest corner of Section 15CD, Tax Lot 100, and extending easterly a distance of about 1,000 feet ending with a temporary cul-de-sac.
