WHEREAS, landowners adjacent to the affected roadway were mailed notice of a public hearing;


WHEREAS, The Observer newspaper published notice for a February 1, 2012 Board of Commissioners public hearing.

SECTION 1: ROAD NAME ADOPTION

Craddock Road is a 1105 m/1 foot long private road easement extending south from Standley Lane across from the south end of Orchard Road, all in Twp. 2S, Range 38 EWM, Section 09 as identified in the attached map and more particularly described as a 20 foot wide right-of-way extending from the northeast corner of property described as Twp. 2S, Range 38 EWM, Section 09, Tax Lot 1300 and terminating at the northeast corner of property described as Twp. 2S, Range 38 EWM, Section 09, Tax Lot 1800.
