petitioner Shows that ever since the town of Hilgard was platted and laid out, portions of the streets hereinafter mentioned have never been traveled; that petitioner and predecessors have kept the same enclosed by a substantial fence, that said streets are of no use or benefit to the public, owing to the fact that petitioner has permitted the public to travel in a road hereinafter mentioned, viz, a line drawn from the South west corner of Lot 6 Block 3, to the S.W. corner Lot 2 Block 6; It appearing to the Court that the hereinafter described streets are of no use to the County,

It is therefore considered and ordered that all of that portion of Cottage Street in the town of Hilgard, lying north of a straight line drawn from the S.E. corner Block 5 to the S.E. corner Lot 6, Block 6, and all that part of Harrison Street lying west of such line, be vacated,

In the matter of the appointment of

Edward Wright as deputy County Clerk.

Now at this time comes J. B. Gilham, County Clerk, and reports to the Court that he has appointed Edward Wright Deputy County Clerk, to serve as such during his term of office. And it appearing to the Court that such appointment is necessary on account of the increased volume of business in the County Clerks office, and especially during the time of registration of voters, and that a reasonable compensation for such services would be \$3.00 per day.

It IS THEREFORE CONSIDERED and ORDERED by The Court, that Edward Wright be and he is hereby appointed Deputy County Clerk at \$3.00 per day, and that the same be paid the same as other claims against the County are paid.

Thereupon it was ordered that Court be now adjourned until tomorrow morning at nine o'clock.
