This Indenture, WITNESSETH, That Wm Aldred

and Leda Aldred his wife, for the consideration of

Five hundred DOLLARS,

to him paid, have bargained and sold, and by these presents do bargain, sell and convey unto the County of Union, State of Oregon, the following described land for road purposes, to-wit:

A strip of land sixty feet wide, being thirty feet on each side of the center line of the La Grande-Joseph Highway as surveyed over and across the N. W. 1/4 of the N. E. 1/4 of Section 10 and the E. 1/2 of the S. E. 1/4 of Section 3, T. 1 N. R. 40 E. W. M., and more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of the West boundary line of the William Aldred property and the La Grande-Joseph Highway, at Station 1624 plus 16 of the survey of the center line of said Highway, which station is approximately 468 feet South of the 1/4 corner between Sections 3 and 10 T. 1 N. R. 40 E. W. M., running thence on a 14 degree curve left 355.1 feet, thence N. 33 50' E. 298.2 ft., thence on a 10 degree curve right 361.2 ft., thence N. 69 57 E. 1900.5 ft., thence on an 8 degree curve right 19 ft., to an intersection with the East boundary line of the William Aldred property at Station 1653 plus 50 of said survey, which station is approximately 916.5 ft. North and 4.9 ft. West of the corner of Sections 2, 3, 10 and 11 T. 1 N. R. 40 E. W. M., containing 4.04 acres more or less.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said land, with its appurtenances, for county road purposes to said Union County and the public therein forever, and, the said Wm Aldred &

Leda Aldred do hereby covenant to and with the said Union County that they are the owners in fee simple of said lands; that they are free from all encumbrances except
