This Indenture Witnesseth, That N. K. West, Trustee, a widower,

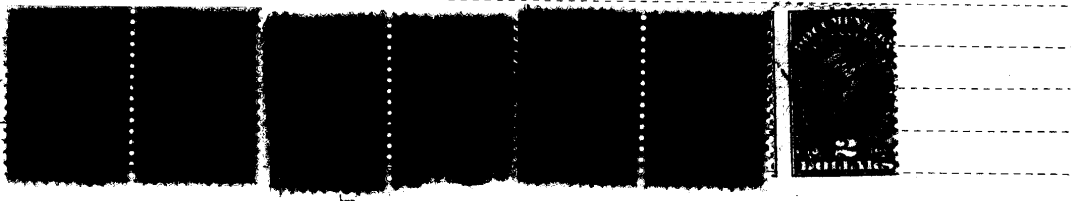

sell and convey unto County of Union, State of Oregon, a municipal corporation,

*the following described premises, to-wit:*  
An undivided one half interest in and to  
Blocks Seven (7) Eight (8), Nine (9), Ten (10), Eleven (11), Twelve (12),  
Thirteen (13), Fourteen (14), Seventeen (17) and Eighteen (18), and Lots one (1),  
Two (2), Seven (7), Eight (8), Nine (9), Ten (10), Eleven (11) and Twelve (12),  
in Block Nineteen (19), all in Williamson's Addition to the City of La Grande,  
County of Union, State of Oregon, together with all vacated streets and alleys  
included within said boundaries.

For the purpose of establishing a memorial park to the memory of the soldiers  
and sailors of Union County, Oregon, who served in the late war, and for grounds  
upon which can be erected and maintained buildings to be used as club rooms and  
meeting places for service and ex-service men of the army, navy and marines, and  
in which park there may be held public gatherings, entertainments and meetings,  
including county fairs.

It is further understood that this deed conveys an undivided one half interest  
in and to the said property to said County of Union, and that the grantor herein  
will convey an undivided one half interest in said grounds to the City of La Grande,  
Union County, Oregon, and that said park shall be operated under reasonable rules  
and regulations by said county of Union and said City of La Grande, and that under  
said regulations there shall be allowed to be held public gatherings, public enter-  
tainments, county fairs, school games, track meets, and other meetings of similar  
public nature.



TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said premises, with their appurtenances, unto the said  
County of Union, State of Oregon, a municipal corporation,

its successors ~~heretofore~~ and assigns forever.

And the said N. K. West, Trustee, a widower, do ~~es~~ hereby cove-  
nant to and with the said County of Union, State of Oregon, a municipal corporation  
its successors  
~~have~~ and assigns, that he is the owner in fee simple of said premises; that they  
are free from all incumbrances, and that he will warrant and defend the same  
from all lawful claims whatsoever.
