to him paid, has bargained and sold, and by these presents do bargain, sell and convey unto the County of Union, State of Oregon, the following described land for road purposes, to-wit:
A strip of land 60 ft. wide, being 30 ft. on each side of the center line survey of Old Oregon Trail, as staked, over and across the land of Union Orchards Co. in the NW 1/4 of the N.W. 1/4 of Sec. 30, Tier 4, S. Range 40 E. of the Willamette Meridian; More particularly described as follows: Commencing at Engineers Sta. 0 plus 00, of said survey, which point is approximately 1255 ft. E. and 173 ft. So. of the NW cor. of said sec. 30, T. 4 S. R. 40 E. W.
