KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That H. N. Prather, unmarried, of Union, County of Union, State of Oregon, in consideration of the sum of Four hundred, twelve and 50/100 Dollars to him in hand paid by the County of Union, State of Oregon, receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, does by these presents give, grant and lease unto the said County of Union and the traveling public thereof, for the purpose of public easement and right of way, the following described premises, to-wit:

A strip of land sixty feet in width through the lands of H. N. Prather, lying in the southwest quarter of the southeast quarter of section thirty-four, in township four south of range forty, east of the Willamette Meridian: said strip of land entering said southwest quarter of the southeast quarter on the north boundary line thereof and running in a southeasterly direction for a distance of 125 rods more or less and leaving said southwest quarter of the southeast quarter of the east boundary line thereof. The line of said strip of land to be identical with and over the same route as is now covered by the County Highway running from Union, Oregon to Medical Springs, Oregon.

To have and to hold and to enjoy the said premises unto the said County of Union, and to the traveling public thereof, for the purpose of public easement and right of way in perpetuity: and the said H. N. Prather does by these presents dedicate the said strip of land as a public highway.

In the Matter of the purchase of land from H. N. Prather as a right-of-way for the Union-Medical Springs Market Road.

Now at this time is presented to the Court the deed of H. N. Prather to a strip of land 60 feet wide in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 34 Tp 4 SR 40 EWM, as a right-of-way for the Union-Medical Springs Market Road and it appearing to the Court that it is necessary that Union County acquire said land for the construction of said Union-Medical Springs Market Road and said deed being in due form,

It is CONSIDERED AND ORDERED that the same be and is hereby accepted and the County Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to draw a warrant on the Market Road Fund of Union County in the sum of \$412.50 in payment therefor.

In the Matter of the application of S. D. Sanders for County Aid.

Now at this time this matter comes on for hearing and it is here now ORDERED that the same be and is hereby continued for the term.

In the Matter of the proposed CoUnty Road petitioned for by S. C. Doty, Et al.

Comes now S. C. Doty, one of the petitioners for the above named proposed County Road, and presents to the Court the petition of himself and others, praying for the location and establishment of a County Road, described as follows, to-wit:

Starting near the center corner of the east line of Section 25, Township 3 N. Range, 39, then straight west along the center line of Section 25 to the center corner of the west line of Sec. 25, Township 3 N. Range 39, then following same line west to center corner of west line of Sec. 26 Township 3 N R 39, then South along Sec. line of 26 & 27 about $\frac{1}{4}$ of a mile, then bearing south of east down the creed across the southwest $\frac{1}{4}$ of the southwest $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec 26 Township 3 NR 39 to pass between Amesbery's House and Barn bearing down the creek across south of east across the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 35 Township 3 NR 39, bearing south of E across the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec 35 Township 3 NR 39, where it joins county road about 40 rods N of Schoolhouse.

And it appearing to the Court that said petition is signed by more than twelve freeholders of this County, residing in the road district where the hereinbefore described road is proposed to be, and that said petition properly specifies the place of beginning, intermediate points and place of termination of said road, and it satisfactorily appearing to the Court that notice has been given by advertisement posted at the place of holding County Court, to-wit: At the Court House in the city of La Grande, Union County, Oregon, and also in three public places in the vicinity of said proposed road to-wit: One on a stump at the beginning of said proposed road, One on a fir tree snag near the corner of the S. C. Doty farm, and one on a gate post at the Brown farm near the terminus of the proposed road, for more than thirty days immediately prior to the presentation of said petition to this Court notifying all persons concerned that application would be made to this Court at its present session and that the notices so posted were in due form and duly signed by the petitioners,
