SECOND JUDICIAL DAY

THURSDAY, JUNE 3rd, 1926.

Court met pursuant to adjournment.

Whereupon the following proceedings were had, to-wit:

In the matter of the monthly report of the County Treasurer and credits given her.

Comes now Florence Bacon, County Treasurer of Union County, Oregon, and presents to the Court certain vouchers, warrants, and receipts showing that she has paid out of the various funds of the County certain sums of money. And it appearing to the Court from an examination of said vouchers and warrants that the sums have been duly paid out of the funds applicable thereto, that the warrants were regularly issued on the order of the Court, and that the Treasurer should have credit upon her account for the same,

In the matter of accepting the deeds of D. A. Phillips, et al., for lands for use as a right-of-way for the Hunter Lane-Pleasant Grove Market Road and the Mount Glenn Market Road.

Now at this time are presented to the Court the deeds of D. A. Phillips and Annie H. Nebeker to lands for use as rights-of-way for the Mount Glenn Market Road and the deeds of N. K. West, C. H. Arnoldus, Victor Johnson, Frank S. Johnson, Nancy Bradshaw, John J. Murchison, O Vandermuellen and S. C. Johnson to lands for use as rights-of-way for the Hunter Lane, and it appearing to the Court that it is necessary and convenient for the County to acquire said lands for use in the construction of said roads,

It is therefore CONSIDERED AND ORDERED that said deeds be and the same are hereby accepted, and the County Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to draw a warrant on the Market Road Fund of the County in the sum of \$100.00 in favor of D. A. Phillips in payment for the land deeded by him.
