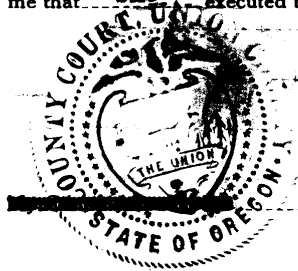

THIS INDENTURE, WITNESSETH, That AnnEtta H. Hawkins , a widow

and his wife, for the consideration of One dollar,

to her paid, has bargained and sold, and by these presents do bargain, sell and convey unto

the County of Union, State of Oregon, the following described land for road purposes, to-wit:

A parcel of land lying in the N.E. 1/4 of Section 32 T 2 S R 38, E.W.M., Union County, Oregon, included in a strip of land thirty (30) feet in width lying on the easterly side of the center line of the La Grande-Iowa School-County Road, and being described as follows:

Beginning at Engineer's center line Station 22+30.55, said Station being 3,697.05 feet North and 129.04 feet West of the South quarter (1/4) corner of Said Section 32., thence on a spiral curve right (the long chord of which bears N. 2°47'19"E) 240 feet; thence on a 477.46 feet radius curve right (the long chord of which bears N. 25°23'51.5"E) 216.82 feet; thence on a spiral curve right (the long chord of which bears N. 48°00'24"E) 240 feet to Engineer's center line Station 29+27.37. The easterly line of said strip of land intersecting the easterly right-of-way of the existing County road and the northly line of said property approximately opposite Stations 23+00 and 26+60 respectively.

The parcel of land to which this description applies contains 0.3 acres, of which 0.2 acres lie within the existing right-of-way, title to which hereby is acknowledged to be in the public, and 0.1 acre lie outside the existing right-of-way.

In the matter of the acceptance of the deed of Annette H Hawkins for right-of-way for county road.

At this time is presented to the county court the deed of Annette H Hawkins, a widow, for a parcel of land to be used for road purposes, described as follows, to-wit: a parcel of land lying in the northeast quarter of section 32, tp 2 south, range 38, EWM, Union County, Oregon, included in a strip thirty (30) feet in width lying on the easterly side of the center line of the La Grande-Iowa School county road, and being described as follows:

Beginning at Engineer's center line station 22+30.55, said station being 3,697.05 feet north and 129.04 feet west of the south quarter corner of said Section 32, thence on a spiral curve right (the long chord of which bears N 2 47' 19"E) 240 feet; thence on a 477.46 feet radius curve right (the long chord of which bears N-25 23' 51.5"E) 216.82 feet; thence on a spiral curve right (the long chord of which bears N 48 00' 24"E) 240 feet to Engineer's center line station 29+27.37. The easterly line of said strip of land intersecting the easterly right-of-way of the existing county road and the northerly line of said property approximately opposite stations 23+00 and 26+60, respectively.

The parcel of land to which this description applies contains 0.3 acres, of which 0.2 acres lie within the existing right-of-way, title to which is acknowledged to be in the public, and 0.1 acre lie outside the existing right-of-way.

And it appearing to the Court that it is necessary for Union County to acquire the land described in said deed for the improvement of the LaGrande-Iowa School County Road,

It is therefore CONSIDERED AND ORDERED that said deed be accepted on behalf of Union County, and that the land described in said deed be declared a part of the right-of-way of the La Grande-Iowa School County Road.
