1848 then was present Hon. J. C. Lewis, Judge  
Edo Eckley, Deputy Sheriff, G. R. Holmes, & W. J. Hunter  
Commissioners Willi Skiff, Clerk.

Due proclamation of the opening of Court having been  
made the following proceedings were had to wit:

In the matter

of  
Road petition } Now comes S J French and  
presents to this court and presents a petition signed  
by more than twelve resident householders of  
Union County Oregon living along and in the  
vicinity of route they ask to be established as a  
County road, described as follows:

Commencing at a point on or near the South East  
corner of S. 31. T. 3. S. 40. E. on the road running from  
Union to the Cove; thence running in a westerly  
direction about two miles to the S. W. corner of Sec 36  
T. 3. S. 40. E. and to intersect the road running  
from Union to La Grande. And it satisfactorily appe-  
aring to the court from proof filed herein that due  
notice of the pendency of these proceedings had been  
given as by law required; that more than twelve  
of said petitioners are legal householders residing in  
the vicinity of said road and that a good and  
sufficient bond has been filed.

It is therefore ordered by the court that Samuel  
Lewis Mortimer Bloom & S. Blanks be appointed  
viewers. & A. B. Campbell Surveyor, to view, survey  
and report upon said proposed road and that they  
meet at the Old Stanton place (Now French's) on the  
15<sup>th</sup> day of Nov. 1848 and duly qualify before entering  
upon the discharge of their duties in this behalf.

Whereupon the court adjourned for the day

State of Oregon, and <sup>that</sup> his term of office continue at the pleasure of ~~the~~ <sup>the</sup> commissioners of this Union County. And it was further ordered that said W<sup>m</sup> Makin file a good and sufficient undertaking with two or more sufficient sureties to be approved by the Court before entering upon the duties of his said office in the sum of \$2,000.<sup>00</sup>

Now at this time it appearing from the report of the viewers and Surveyors report on the proposed road connecting the Union + La Grande Co<sup>rs</sup> road with the Union + Levi Co<sup>rs</sup> road therefore filed, that the same is incorrect. It is ordered and adjudged that the same be laid over until the next term of this court for correction.

Whereupon the court adjourned for the day

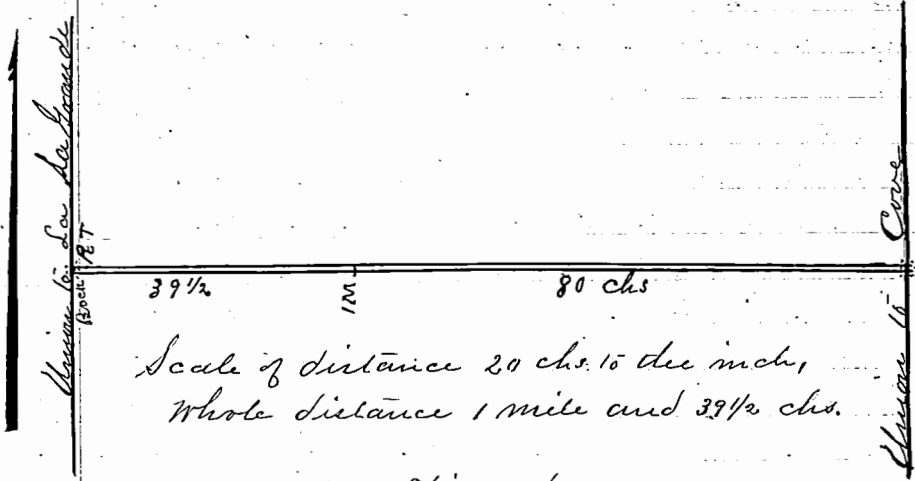
Now comes for a second reading the report of the views and surveyor heretofore appointed to view survey and report on a proposed road leading from an point at or near the S.E. corner of Section 31, T. 3, S. R. 40, E. on the road running from Union to the Cove thence running in a westerly direction about two miles to the S.W. corner of Sec 26 T. 3 S. R. 39, E. there to intersect the road running from Union to La Grande all of which points are in Union County and said views and surveyor having viewed and surveyed said proposed road, reports that said proposed route as prayed for in petition as a practicable route and recommends the same to be opened and established as a county road.

And it appearing to the satisfaction of the court that the proceedings herein have been regular and in conformity with the statute in such cases made and provided, and no person having filed complaint for damages or otherwise remonstrated against the location of said route as a public highway,

Therefore it is hereby ordered and adjudged that said route be established as a county road and that the same be opened as such county road according to the official plat and survey of said route, and filed notes thereof of which the following is a copy to wit:
