We, the undersigned residents of and citizens of Union County Oregon hereby petition the Hon County Court of said County, at the next regular term to relocate the County Road, located and described heretofore as - commencing near J P Baird's house - thence running west one mile - thence north one half mile - thence 1 mile and 3/4 chains to the terminus of the road, at a post set at the margin of the foot hill road from Labrande to Union, whose distance, two miles and 11 chains - said road to be relocated and described as follows - commencing at the rock placed at the center of sec-13 town 4 south R 3 E thence west on the subdivision line to the center of sec-14 - thence north on the subdivision line to the 1/4 sec corner on the north line of the land sec 14 - thence west on the section line until it intersects the Labrande and Union Road.

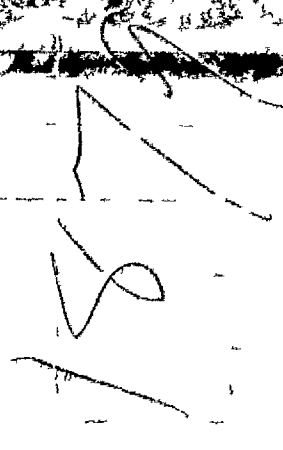

Campbell Surveyor to view, survey and report on said proposed Road, and that they meet at the Tucker School House on the 18th day of Sept. 1849 and after duly qualifying proceed to their duties in said behalf.

In the matter of
Road Petition
of T. B. M. Green et al.

Now at this time was presented the petition of T. B. M. Green and more than twelve other citizens and house holders living along and in the vicinity of a route they ask to be located as a County Road, as follows to wit: Commencing near T. P. Bairds house thence running west one mile thence north one half mile, thence one mile and 81 chains to the Terminus of the road at a post set at the margin of the foot hill road from La Grande to Union. And it appearing to the court that due and legal notice of the pendency of these proceedings have been given and a sufficient bond having been filed. And the proceedings herein having been regular. It was ordered that John Robbins, W. F. Ficklin and George Ames be appointed viewers and H. B. Campbell Surveyor to view, survey and report upon said proposed Road and that they meet at the residence of T. B. M. Green on the 22nd day of Sept. A. D. 1849 and after being duly sworn as such viewers, proceed to view and lay out said proposed route and report their proceedings in that behalf to this court at the next regular term of this court.

At a Regular Term of the Co. Commissioners Court begun and held at the Court House in Union in Union County Oregon on the 5th day of Nov. A.D. 1879 present Hon. M. C. Craig Judge of said County W^m H. Hunter and H. P. Holmes Co. Commissioners S. C. Swackhamer, Sheriff, and Willis Skiff, Co. Clerk.

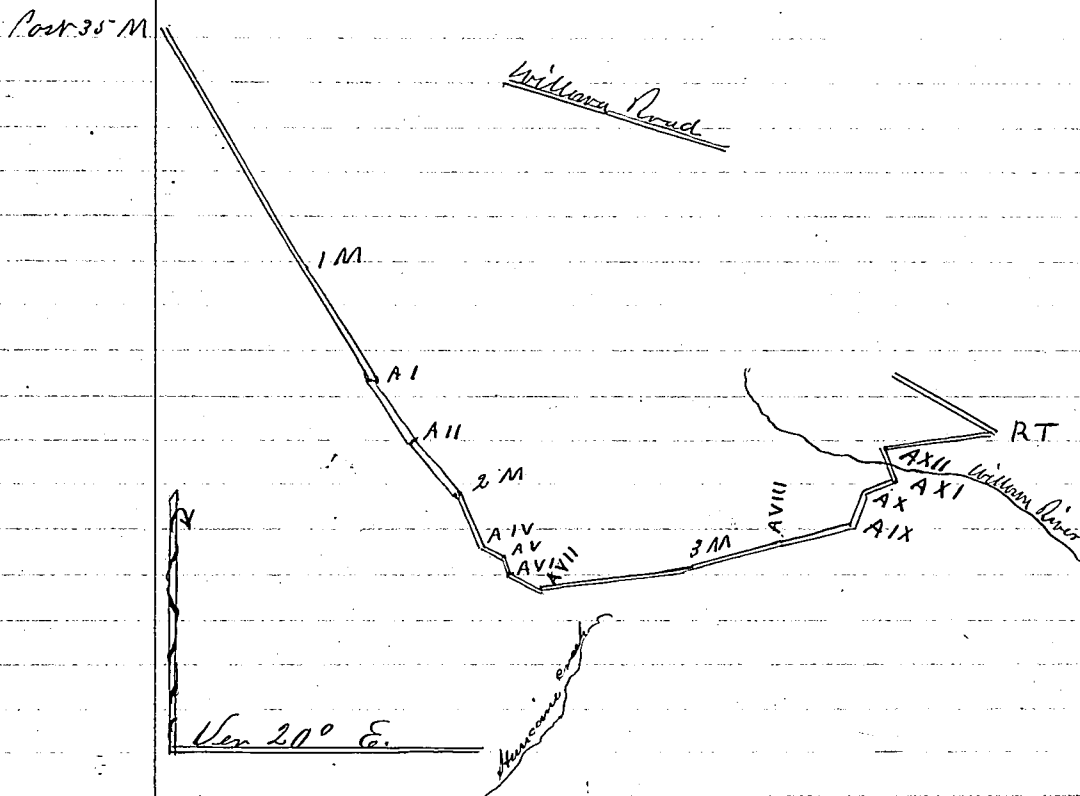
Due proclamation of the opening of Court having been made the following proceedings were had to wit:

T. B. W. Green Road

Now at this time
 came up for the second reading the report
 of the viewers upon the road petitioned for by
 L. S. Blakely and others, which report
 was ordered spread upon the records of this
 court. Said report being as follows, to wit:

To the Hon County Court of Union
 County Oregon, we the undersigned viewers
 appointed to view and relocate a County
 Road from a rock placed at the center of
 Section 13 T 4 S. R. 39 East, thence in a
 westerly direction to intersect the La Grande

and Union, County submit the following report:

We met on the day named in your order to wit: The 23rd day of Sept. A.D. 1849 and not having field notes, adjourned until October 11th 1849 at which time we met and after being duly sworn, in company with the surveyor proceeded to view, survey and layout said Road as directed and as shown by surveyors Plat submitted herewith we find the Road to be located on suitable ground and necessary to the Public convenience, and therefore recommended its establishment as a County Road

And it appearing to the satisfaction of the Court that the proceeding herein have been in all things regular and in accordance with Law and the Statute in such cases made and provided, and no remonstrance having been filed or damage claimed by reason of the location thereof or otherwise and in consideration of the report of said Viewers,

It was considered ordered and adjudged that said route be established a County Road and public highway and that the proper Road Supervisor cause the same to be opened in accordance with the Surveyors report and that they of which the following is a copy to wit: Commencing at a stone near J.
