third That Road District No 7 now has more County Road than the Road Tax of the District will keep in good repair

fourth That granting of said Road would be of no special benefit to the County but would incur a greater expense upon the County and especially a <sup>an</sup> ~~burden~~ <sup>burden</sup> tax upon said District No 7
