Now at this time appeared Mr. Baker Esq. in behalf of the Citizens of La Grande and vicinity and ask the appropriation of this Court of Funds for the Improvement of the County Road leading from La Grande to what is known as the Granger Hall, through what is known as the "Gecklees" Lane.

And it appearing to the Court, that an appropriation should be made for said Road.

It is hereby ordered and adjudged by the Court - that orders be drawn on the County Treasurer of this County for the sum equal to the sum that may be raised by the Citizens of La Grande not exceeding the sum of \$500⁰⁰ - for the Improvement of the County Road from La Grande to the Granger Hall, through what is known as the "Gecklees" lane, east

from La Grande and that Ben. Brown
 he and the same is hereby appointed
 to take Charge of all the Funds and
 Labor which may be subscribed by the
 said Citizens of La Grande not exceed-
 ing the Sum of \$500⁰⁰ and expend
 the same in the Improvement of said
 Road — Provided That the said im-
 provements shall be by graveling said
 Road and that the said Benj. Brown
 shall be allowed the Sum of \$25⁰⁰ per day
 for his said Services on said Road to
 be paid out of the said Appropriation
 and the said Subscription.

In the Matter of
 County Road,
 petitioned for
 by Calvin Knapp
 et al.

On this day, come
 Calvin Knapp and presents to the Court
 the Petition of himself and others, praying
 for the location of a County Road as
 follows, to wit:

Commencing at the N. W. Corner of the
 $\frac{1}{4}$ of the $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 9. T 2. S of R
 38 E. running thence East one Mile,
 intersecting the County Road, said
 Road running East one Mile then
 Commencing at the Terminus of said
 Road, from East $1\frac{1}{4}$ mile, thence
 South $\frac{1}{4}$ mile, thence East intersecting
 the Summerville and Uniontown Road.

And it satisfactory appearing to the
 Court, from the Proofs filed herein,
 that due Notice of the Pendency of these
 Proceedings has been given as by
 Law required. That more than twelve
 of said Petitioners were householders
 residing in the Vicinity of said road
 and that a good and sufficient bond
