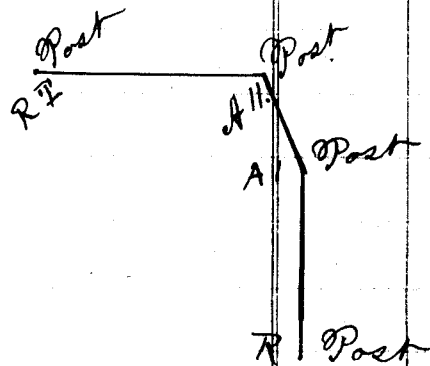

Now at this time was read the viewers report on an proposed change of County road petitioned for by J. A. A. Wilson and others which said report was laid over for further consideration until tomorrow.

In the matter of }  
 Liquor License }

Now at this time came on to be heard the petition of Arthur Warrick and M. W. Lesley applicants for liquor license, said applicants having filed a petition with the court praying for a license to sell spirituous liquors in less quantities than one quart for a period of one year from the seventh day of July A. D. 1880, in Island City Precinct, Union County Oregon, which said petition was signed by a majority of the legal voters of said Precinct.

And it appearing to the court from the proofs filed herein that the competency of this proceeding has been given as by law required and that petitioners A. Warrick and M. W. Lesley has filed a good and sufficient bond has been given for the sum of five hundred dollars which bond was approved by the court.

Petitioners also filed with the Clerk of this court a receipt from the County Treasurer showing that they had deposited in the treasury the sum of \$100<sup>00</sup> that being the amount required by law for license for one year.

It was after due consideration had by the court ordered that license issue to said A. Warrick and M. W. Lesley authorizing them to sell spirituous liquors in less quantities than one quart in Island City Precinct for a period of one year from the 7<sup>th</sup> day of July A. D. 1880
