In the matter
of
Sheep Inspector

Now at this time in accordance with an Act of the Legislative Assembly of the State of Oregon entitled "An Act to prevent the spreading of contagious and infectious diseases among sheep: It is hereby ordered by the Court E. R. Holmes be and he is hereby appointed Inspector of sheep for Union County Oregon and that he duly qualify as such Inspector by filing in this court a bond in the penal sum of Two thousand Dollars conditioned for the faithful performance of the duties of his said office.

In the matter of petition
of appropriation on the
La Bunde and Union
County Road.

Now on this day was presented the petition of S. P. Newhard and others praying an appropriation out of the County Fund of Four hundred Dollars to be applied in repairing the County road along the foot hill from La Bunde to Union. And it appearing to the Court that said appropriation would be a good and just appropriation and is absolutely needed

and would be a great benefit to the County.
It is therefore ordered and adjudged that there be appropriated out of the County Treasury for Union County the sum of \$400⁰⁰ to be applied in the repair of the County Road known as the "Yost Hill Road" between Union and La Grande. It is further ordered that Joseph H. Shambaugh Superintendent the said work and that said amount be paid upon his order to the County Clerk.
