The undersigned citizens of Pine Valley and vicinity, would respectfully represent that a certain <sup>road</sup> ~~road~~ leading from Pine Valley to Brown-Lees Ferry on Snake River and described as follows, to-wit:-

Beginning at the terminus of the County Road leading through Pine Valley and following the old Brown Lee Wagon road to the head of Trail Canyon, thence down the canyon to its mouth on Snake River, petitioned for by A. P. Greener, et al, was established and ordered open, by the Hon. Court of Union County, on July 9th, 1881, the construction of said road being commenced in the Spring of 1883, under the supervision of James H. Summers an appropriation having been granted by the Hon. Court to assist in the construction of said road, work progressed until the funds were all applied and further construction was abandoned for lack of means.

We your petitioners would therefore respectfully ask your Hon. Body to grant an appropriation of Five Hundred Dollars (\$50000) to assist us in the completion of said road for which we will ever pray, etc.

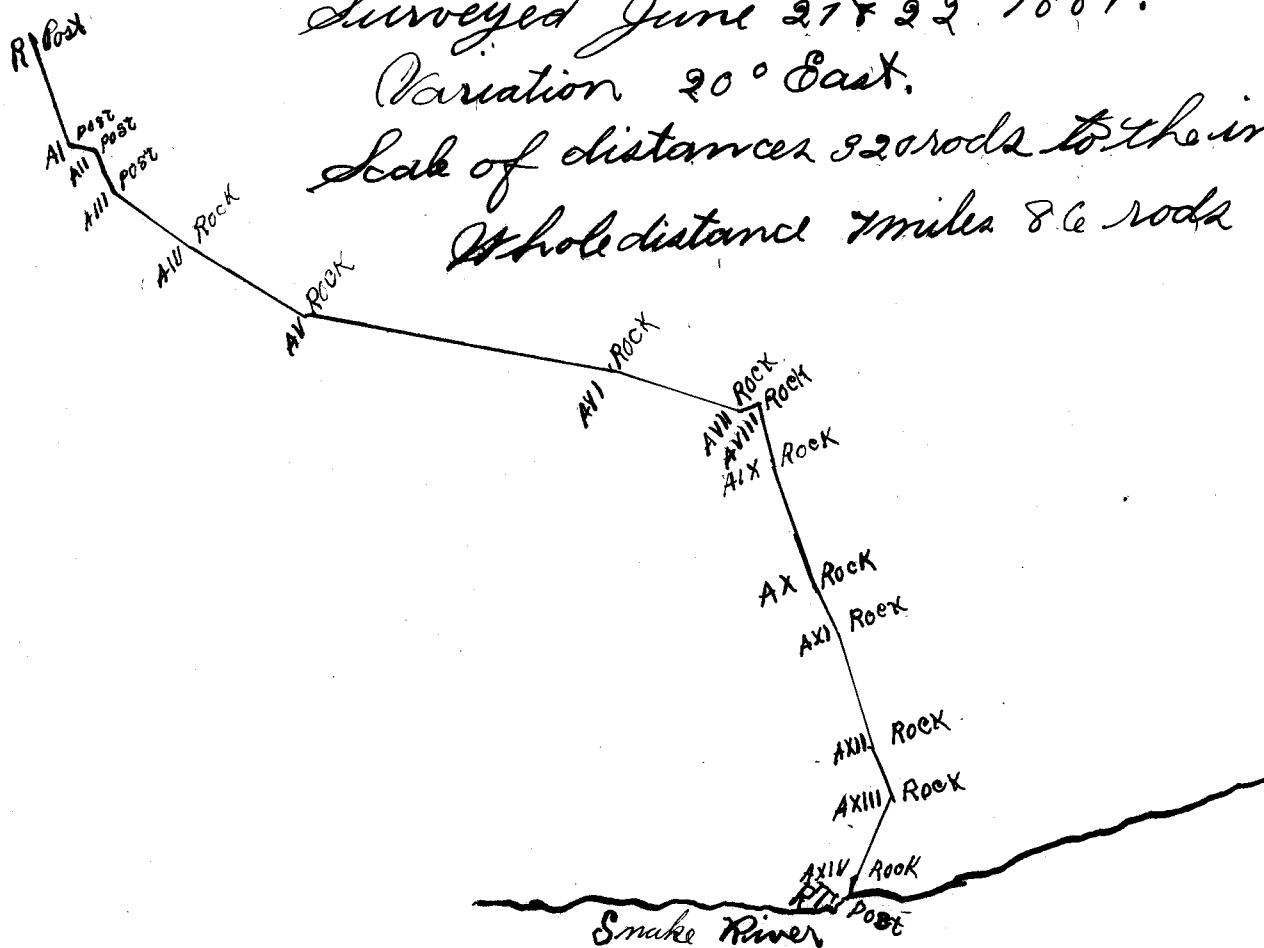

Road from Pine Valley to Snake River, established in 1881, upon petition of A. P. Greener, et al, and it appearing to the Court from the evidence before it that the tax payers of that section of the Co. have subscribed about \$450.00 in money, work and labor for the completion of said road & that said road is a necessary public highway for the people of the Co. & that it ought to be opened early the following spring & that it will take about \$500.00 in addition to the work and labor subscribed to complete the same. It is therefore ordered that there be and hereby is appropriated out of the Gen. Funds of the Co. in the hands of the Co. Treasurer the sum of \$500.00 to be applied in completing said Co. Road. And it is further ordered that..... be and he

is hereby appointed Superintendent to take charge of said appropriation, draw and receipt for the warrants upon the Co. Treasurer therefor, & to superintend the construction of said road & the expenditure of said money thereon & to Collect & apply as well the money & labor subscribed by the citizens of said County, therefor, and he shall before drawing said warrants or expending any part of said appropriation qualify by taking an oath to faithfully discharge his duties as such superintendent & by executing to the Co. of Union a good and sufficient bond with two or more sureties in the sum of five hundred dollars to the approval of the Co. Judge, conditioned that he will well and faithfully discharge his duties as such superintendent, that he will honestly apply the money appropriated to the purpose of the appropriation and that he will render to the Court on or before the July Term, 1891, thereof a true and correct account of his trust & settle with the Co. Court therefor. The appropriation is made upon the condition that the petitioners for the same shall raise by subscription & apply upon said road an amount in work, labor & money equal to the amount herein appropriated by the Court.

Provided however, that no work or labor shall be done upon said road under this appropriation nor shall the warrants therefor be drawn by said superintendednt before the first day of March, 1891 & then only in case that the road for which the appropriation is made remains in this County, and is subject to the jurisdiction of this Court.

And it appearing to the satisfaction of the Court from proof filed herein that due and proper notice of the pendency of these proceedings has been given as by law required; that more than twelve of said petitioners are legal householders residing in the vicinity of said road, and that a good and sufficient

bond has been filed. It is therefore hereby ordered by the Court, that Joseph Bugg, Leonard Lang and W. N. Young be appointed viewers and Eugene Chase Surveyor to view survey and report upon said proposed road and that they meet at about the house of Mr. W. Mullen on the 21<sup>st</sup> day of June A. D. 1881 and duly qualify before entering upon the discharge of their duties in this behalf.

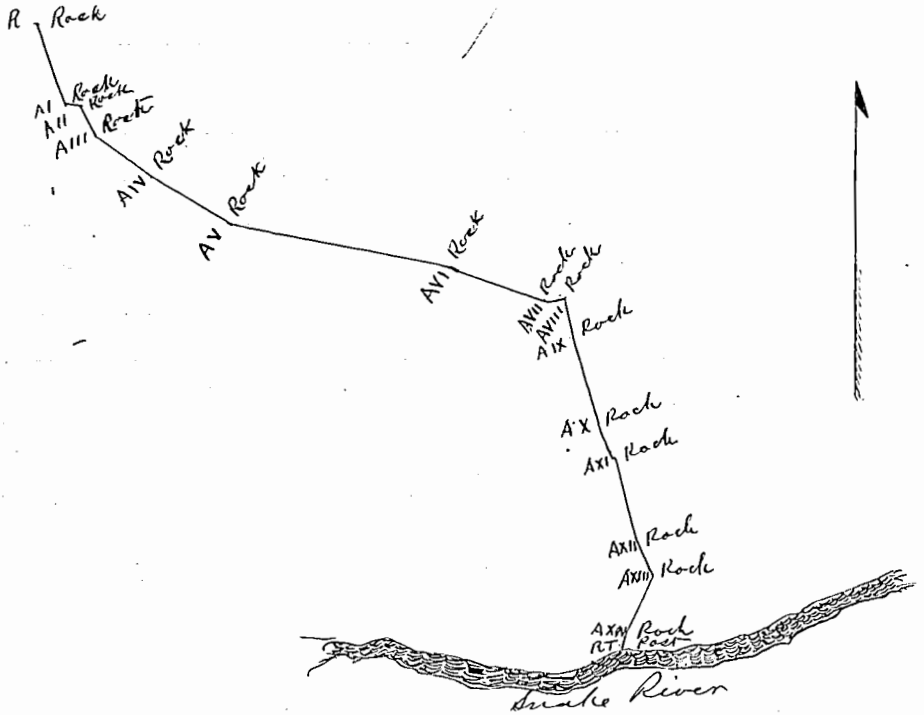
