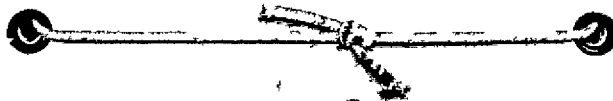

County road in the way of grading turpentine
and drainage and bridging, and appoint some
responsible person to oversee the faithful
performance of said labor

In the matter of Rock
Creek and Grand
Ronde Precinct.

Now at this time
It was ordered by the Court the voting Pre-
cincts of Grand Ronde and Rock
Creek be and they are hereby consolida-
ted into one and shall be known as
Rock Creek Precinct and the place
of voting to be at the house of Robert
Young, in said Precinct.

In the matter of appropriation
on the Willow Canyon
bridge.

Now on this day
It was ordered by the Court that \$200⁰⁰ be and
the same is hereby appropriated to be expend-
ed on what is known as the Willow Can-
yon bridge at the foot of the Willow Canyon
and J. H. W. Lubbin is hereby appointed
superintendent to superintend said work
and issue certificate therefor.

In the matter of the petition
of citizens of area
appropriation on what
is known as the foot hill
road.

Now at this time
was presented the petition of S. F. Spowhara for
an appropriation of \$600⁰⁰ to be expended
on the foot hill road between La Grande and
Union and after due consideration had
by the Court, it is considered by the Court
that said petition be dismissed.

Whereupon the court adjourned until to-
morrow morning at 9 o'clock.
