next regular session July 6th 1880

That they cause a County Road to be
viewed laid out and located in said
county according to the statutes made
and provided as follows

Beginning at the south east corner
of the north west $9\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 24
Township 3 South of Range 45th E. 11th W.
Running thence west, on the half
section line, to the south east corner
of the north west $9\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 22
said town and range: thence north
on half ($\frac{1}{2}$) section line to the south
east corner of the south west $9\frac{1}{4}$
of Section 22 Town 2 South and Range
43rd E. 11th W. = thence west one half ($\frac{1}{2}$)
mile to the south west corner of sect-
ion 22 aforesaid: thence north on
section line to the south west corner

of Section 3 town and range aforesaid
 thence in a northerly direction, on
 the most practicable route, to the
 north east corner of the north west
 1/4 (1/4) of Section 2 Township One (1)
 of said range, 45 Town and there
 terminating.
