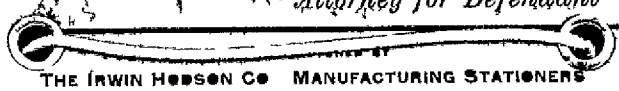

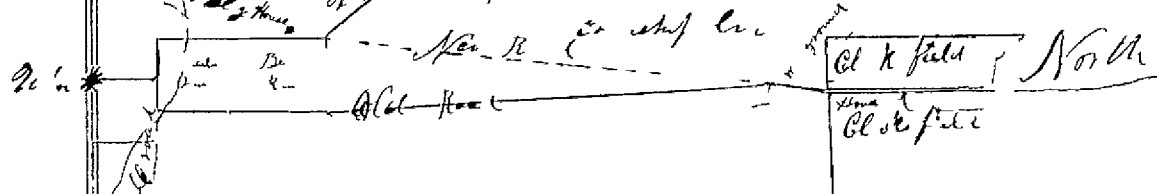

We the undersigned
 request that review be appointed to
 review and relocate a part of the route
 between Union and Forest-Cove as
 described below for several reasons some
 of which are as follows viz One mile of
 the present road runs parallel and within
 one half a mile of the County Road between
 La Grande and Union the proposed change
 would save the expense of one bridge ^{across Jule creek} and
 one mile of road to be kept in repair The
 new road being over as good ground and
 very nearly the same distance as per diagram



The review to commence at the N.W corner
 of the S W 1/4 of Sec 7 T 4 S of Range 40 E or
 about 1/4 of a mile N of Blyzel House on the town-
 ship line there running on a direct line until
 it intersects the old road near Clark's ranch
 and vacating all that part of the old road
 from that point to where it intersects the
 County road leading to the Saw mill on Cattaraugus
 Oak The new road will intersect the old road
 half a mile ^{at present} of the wet ground near Clark's field on it as it

It hereby gives notice
that the competition will be permitted
to the County Commissioners of Union
County, State of Oregon at their
next session to change the
location of the road between the town of Union
and Forest Grove as follows

To Commerce (connecting with the Logans
& Union Road) at a point $\frac{1}{4}$ of a mile
North of Martin Bluff House on the town ship
line at the N West corner of the South West
Quarter of Section 7 Town 4 Range 10
East and running in a direct line to
the South East Corner of Cattle Clark's
Parcel when it connects with the old
road, and to vacate the old road
from that point to where it intersects
the ^{county} road running from Union to the
Chimney Creek Saw Mill

Whereas a petition was presented at the May term of the County Court of Union Co Oregon for a review and relocation ^{of a part} of the road between Union and Horist Cove in said County as follows to commence at the N W corner of the S W $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec 7 town 4 S of Range 40 E or about one fourth of a mile North of Martin Blye house - on the township line between 39 & 40 - Run on a direct line to the corner of C. Clark's field until it intersects the old road near that place

Now therefore I M. C. Israel hereby undertake and by these presents bind myself to the County Court of Union Co Oregon to pay the sum necessarily expended in viewing and surveying said road provided said viewers shall report the same to not be a practicable route

Now at this time was presented a petition praying for a change in a County Road between Union and forest Cove commencing as follows

" By at the N.W. corner of the S.W. 1/4 of Sec 7 T4 S of range
 " 44 E or about 1/4 of a mile N. of Blige House on the T.P.
 " line thence running on a direct line until it intersects
 " the old road near Clarke's Ranch and vacating all that
 " part of the old road from that point to where it intersects
 " the County Road leading to the Saw mill on Galhorne
 " Creek - Said petition was also accompanied by a
 remonstrance comprising about two thirds more names than said petition whereupon it was considered by the Court that said petition be not allowed

In the matter of

Now at this time came up for consideration claims for damages herein before applied for on a proposed County Road commencing as follows Sec 13 N.E. cor of Sec 13 T.P. 3 R. Range 44 E. 1/4 mile N. and running thence to Mitchell's Bridge - and it appearing to the Court that there has been damages allowed by juries herein before appointed by the Court to assess the same and that the petitioners for said road are unwilling to pay said damages It is ordered by the Court that said petition be not allowed
