herby appointed as Viewers and S. L. Curtis Surveyor
to meet Apr 13th 1889 at Crockett at ten o'clock AM

From Oro Dell to St. Roberts

Now at this time was read for the first time the report of Viewers heretofore appointed to view a proposed County road leading commencing at the North End of the bridge across the river at Oro Dell in said County down the said river on the North side thereof by the way of John Ladd's house on the nearest and most practicable route to intersect the County road at St. Roberts and a remonstrance having been filed and issue having been docketed, the further Consider of said matter was postponed until tomorrow at 2 o'clock P.M. Court then adjourned until tomorrow at Nine O'clock

At this time the justice Commissioner of the matter of a Comity road from Orrs Hill to RR bridge having come up the report of the viewers appointed to view a road from the end of the bridge across Grand Ponds Cove at Orrs Hill thence down said river on the North side thereof by way of Amr Saddle to RR bridge and J. S. Nepley appeared and filed a remonstrance thereto and also a claim for damages caused by depreciation of lands by the crossing thereof of said road J. S. Nepley also appeared and filed a claim for damages caused in like manner and it appearing to the Court that there was a greater number of remonstrators than petitioners in said matter

it is ordered that said petition be not allowed.
