pray, that your honorable Board
will lay out and establish a
County Road along the line herein
described to wit:

Commencing at the
Quarter Section corner between
Section N^o 13 in Township 4 South
in Range 39 East and Section N^o
18 in Township N^o 4 South in Range
40 East and at the N W corner of
E. H. Lewis field near the town of Union,
Thence due West along the Quarter
Section line One and one half miles to
the quarter section stake at the center
of Section N^o 14 in Township 4 S in
Range 39 East. Thence due North
along the quarter Section line One
half mile (1/2) to the Section line between
Sections 11 & 14 Thence due West
along the Section line between
Sections 11 & 14 10 & 15 9 & 16 8 & 17 7 & 18
until it intersects and joins the
County Road known as the Union
and Gadd Hills Road which extends
from the Town of Union along the foot
hills to Gadd's Cañon - and for the
establishment of the above described
line of Road your petitioners will
ever pray,

 3/4 mile thence due North along the Section

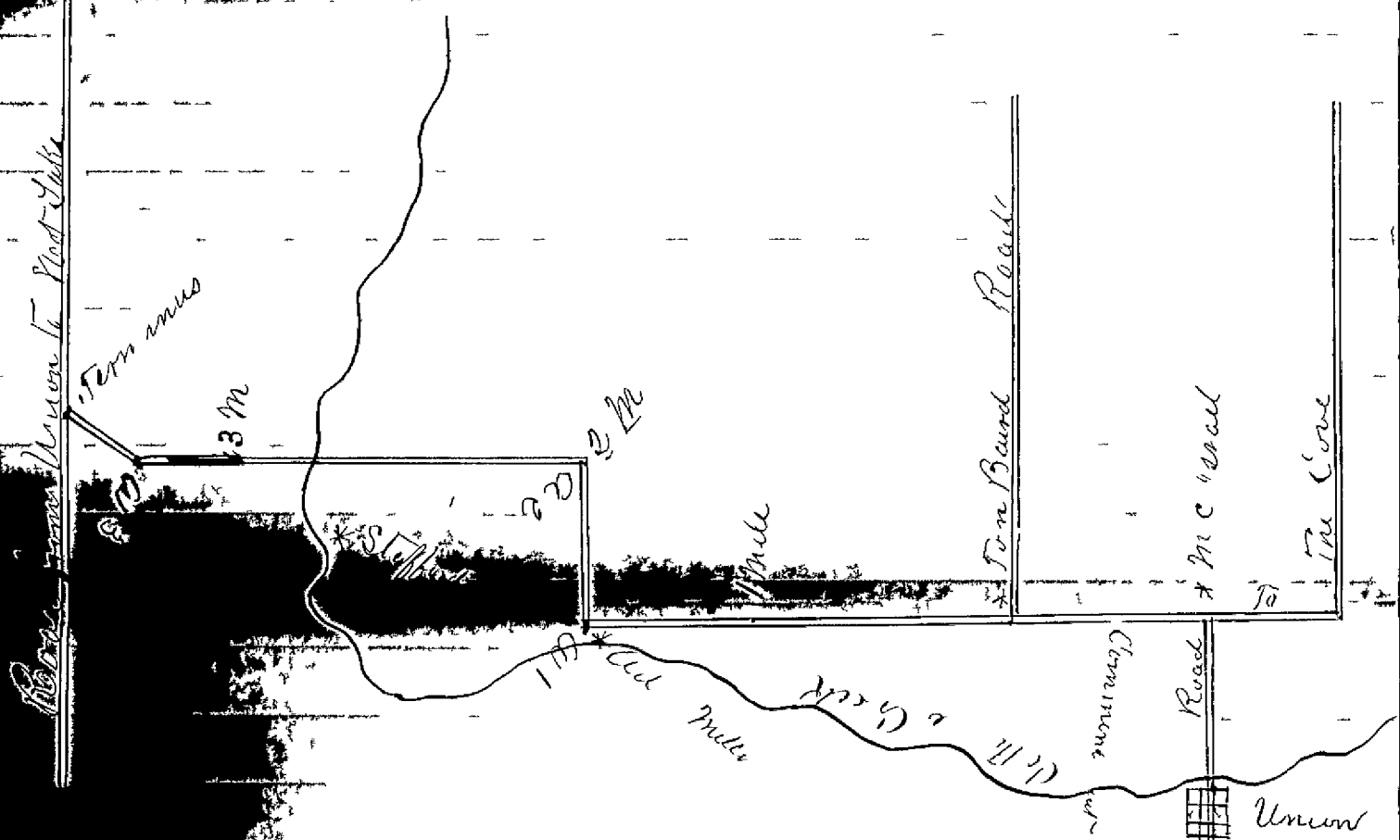
To the Hon Board of Commissioners for

sworn and taking to our assistance J. L.
Curtis as Surveyor we proceeded to view out
and survey said Road in accordance with
the Plat and Notes of survey herein
enclosed, and further that we deem the
Route ~~practicable~~ for a County Road and
calculating to be of general benefit to the
Citizens of Union County

 half Miles (1 1/2) to a Post No 1 thence N One half mile (1/2) to
 a Post No 2 thence N One and one fourth mile (1 1/4) to a Post
 No 3 thence N 1/2, 58° W Eighteen Chs (18) to the terminus
 of the Road at a stake set at the side of the
 Road leading from Union to the Hot Lake.
