The undersigned, householders of Union County, Oregon, residing in the vicinity where the hereinafter described road is proposed to be, respectfully petition your Honorable body to lay out, alter and establish a County road within said County on the following line or route, to-wit: Commencing at the South East corner of the South West  $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 2 Township 3 South of Range 39 East, W. M. and running thence West  $\frac{1}{2}$  mile to the South West corner of said Section 2, thence north  $1\frac{1}{2}$  mile to the north west corner of the South West  $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 35, Township 2 South of Range 39 East, W. 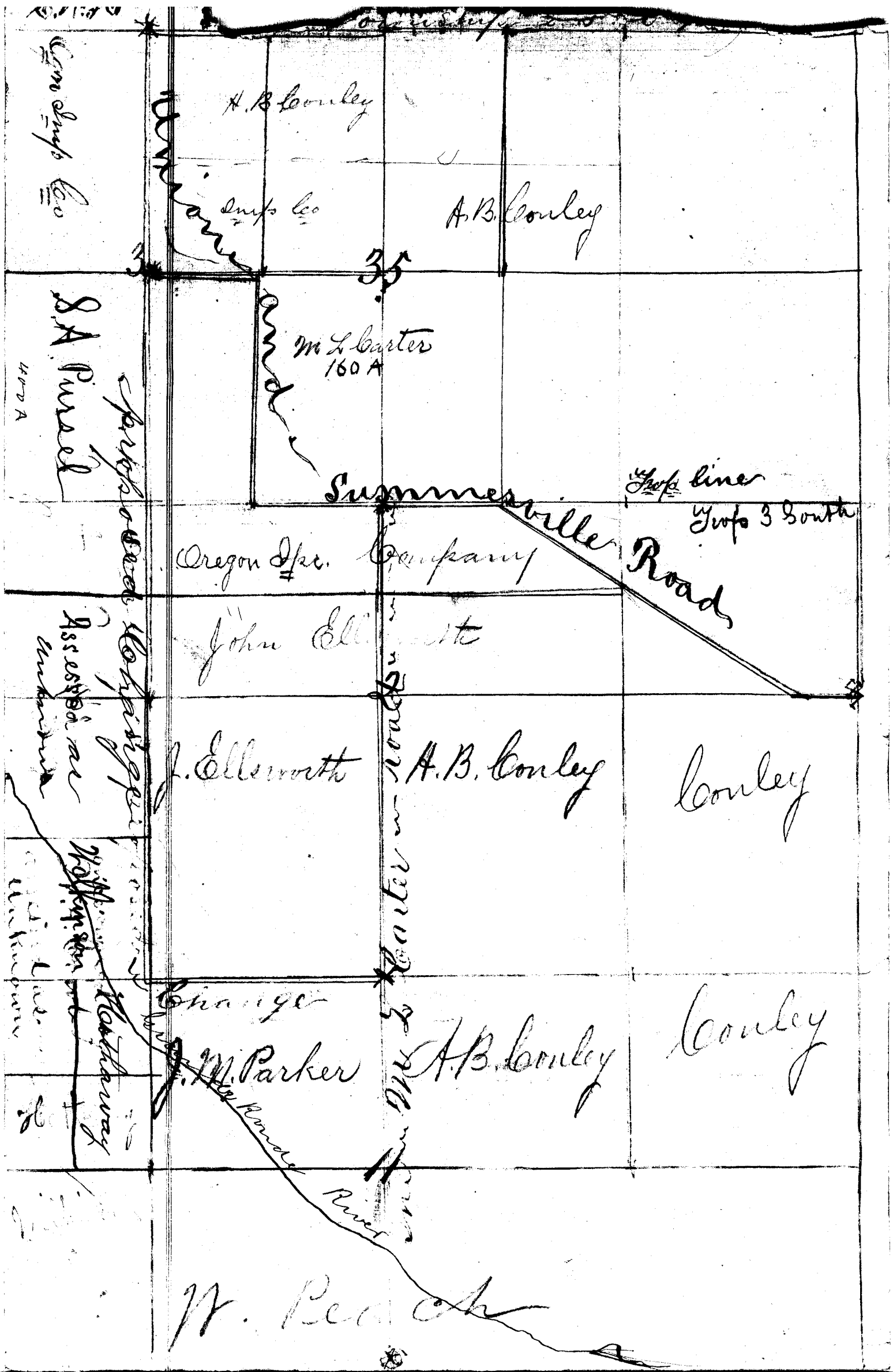

Trinkham and represents to the Court through his duly verified petition, that he is a resident of Multnomah County Oregon and has been for over a year and a half last past, that he has been in Union County since April 7<sup>th</sup> '89, that he is sick and destitute and without means of support and unable to employ medical attendance, that he has no relatives in Union County and no friends who are able and willing to assist him, and he therefore asks the Court to make an order admitting him to the County Poor House, and providing him with medical aid until such time as he is able to work and earn a support for himself. It is therefore considered and ordered that said J. P. Trinkham be admitted to the County Poor House and given such medical treatment and other aid as his needs may require.
