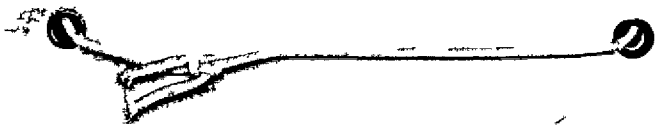

The undersigned, householders of Union County, Oregon, residing in the vicinity where the hereinafter described road is proposed to be, respectfully petition your Honorable body to lay out, alter and establish a County road within said County on the following line or route, to-wit:

Commencing on the County road as at present traveled ~~at the section line between sections 2 and 3 and at a~~ stake at the top of the hill about 15 rods East of the N.W. corner of Sec 11 T 2 R 39 E N M. Thence in a North West direction along the top of the hill about twenty rods more or less to the section line between Secs 2 & 3 thence North to the N.W. corner of NE quarter of NE quarter Sec 2 at the old road as at present traveled <sup>and then terminate.</sup> And to vacate the road as at present traveled from the N.W. corner of NE quarter of Sec 11 T 2 R 39 E N M. running thence diagonally across the O.E. 1/4 of NE 1/4 Sec 2 and <sup>along North side of NE 1/4 of NE 1/4 said Sec 2 to the terminus of</sup> ~~the proposed road~~ <sup>to the county Road</sup>
