On this day came J. L. McKenzie who presents to the Court the petition of himself and 27 others, praying for the establishment of a County Road described as follows, to-wit: Beginning in the Public Highway and at the N.W. corner of the N.E. 1/4 of the S.E. 1/4 of Section 33 T17N R 35 E.M.M. thence running South a distance of 1/2 miles, thence East 1/4 of a mile intersecting a public highway And it satisfactorily appearing to the Court, from proof filed herein, that due notice of the pendency of this proceeding has been given as by law required; that more than twelve of said petitioners are legal householders residing in the vicinity of said road, and that a good and sufficient bond has been filed; It is therefore ordered by the Court that Erno Fisher, James P. Childers and John Cantrell be appointed viewers, and J. L. Curtis Surveyor to view, survey and report upon said Proposed Road and
