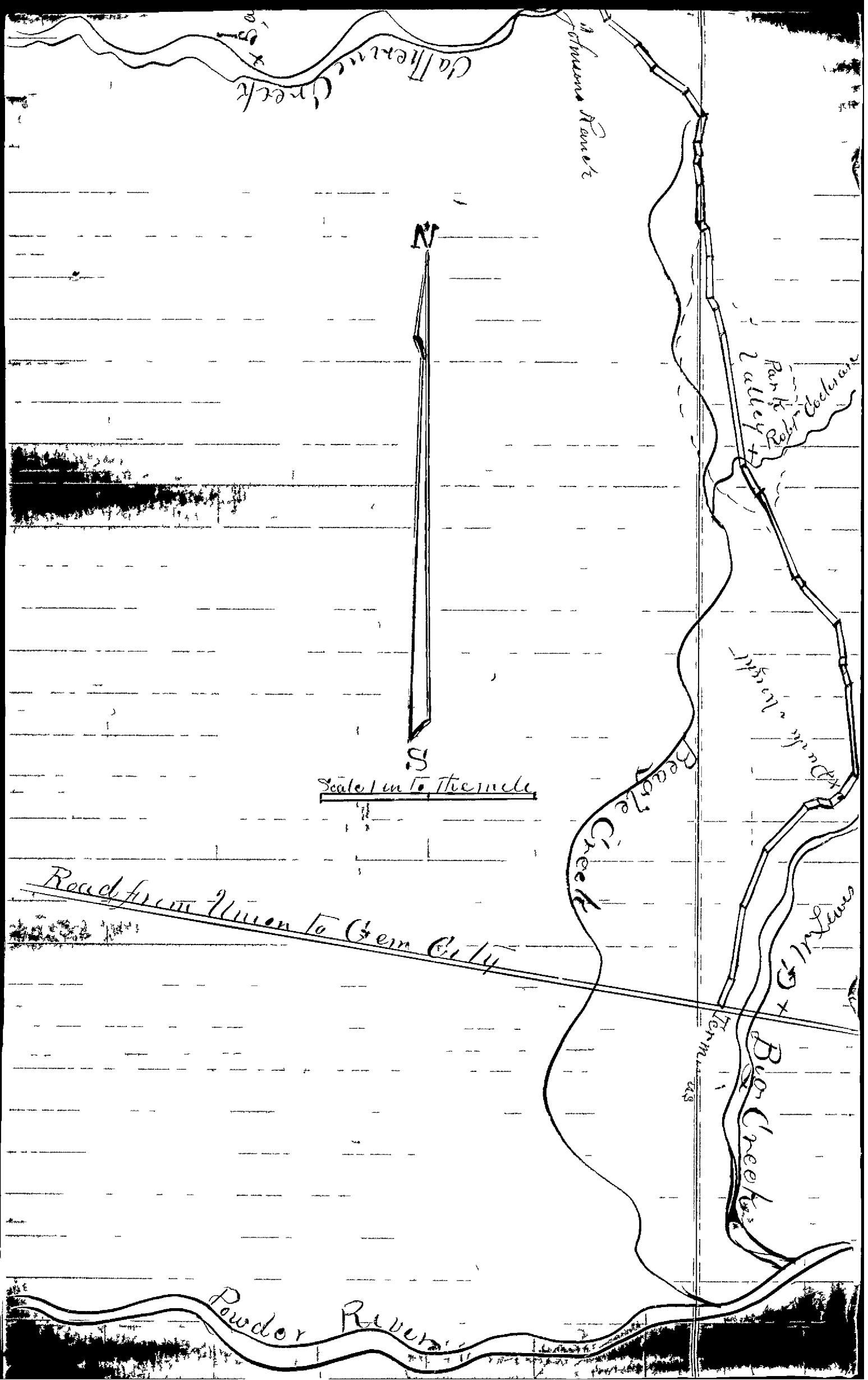

At a Special Session of the County Court began and held at the Court House in Laporte Union County Oregon in pursuance of an Order made at the Regular Term in March 1871 there were present Hon. E. G. Prainey County Judge B. H. Lewis and A. C. Smith County Commissioners Arthur Wamuk Sheriff and J. M. Black County Clerk

Due proclamation of the Opening of Court having been made the following proceedings were had

In the Matter of County
Roads

Now at this time was read for first time for the location of a County Road commencing at the town of Union in Union County Oregon thence via Pyles Canyon and terminating at the Glover Bridge on Powder River

In the Matter of Cancelling
County Orders

Now at this time comes J. B. Richart County Treasurer and returned to the Court the sum of two thousand and thirty three $\frac{25}{100}$ dollars in County funds. Whereupon it was ordered that said Treasurer have a credit for the sum of \$2033 $\frac{25}{100}$ and that Union County have a credit for said sum of \$2033 $\frac{25}{100}$ and that the County Clerk mark said County Orders as cancelled this day

Second Judicial Day

April 18th 1871

Court met pursuant to adjournment. Same Officers present as on yesterday

Due proclamation of the Opening of Court having been made the following Business was transacted

In the Matter of the appointment of Viewers

Now at this time was read for the second time a petition praying for the location by the Court of a County Road in Union County commencing at the Town of Union in said County to commence at said Town thence through the Pyle Cañon on the East Side thereof to follow the Original Survey as near as practicable to Pyles Ranch thence southerly to the divide between Grande Ronde Valley and Powder River thence southerly in the straightest and most feasible line to the house of Geo W Lewis near Big Creek, thence on the straightest and most feasible line to the house of A J Tucker, thence on the most practicable line to the house of George Sanders, thence on the straightest and most feasible line to the house of A J Brown, thence on the straightest and most feasible line to the Town of Sparta, thence on the straightest and most practicable line to the terminating point which is at Glovers Bridge on Powder River all of which points and places are in Union County Oregon. Which petition was signed by forty three residents householders residing in the vicinity and along the line of the said proposed road, and said petitioners having

filed a sufficient Bond in accordance of law which Bond was duly approved and accepted by the Court, And proof of notice being posted according to law being duly verified according to law Whereupon the Court appointed C. H. Prescott, John Robbins and Thomas Kating Viewers and J. L. Curtis Surveyor to meet at the house of Ben Stantons in Union on the 25th day of April 1871 at 9 O'clock A.M. and after being duly sworn in accordance with the law proceed to view and mark out said road and report their proceedings to this Court at its next term thereof.

made the view in accordance with the Survey
and field notes of the Surveyor Daniel Chaplin
which accompanies this report. That we are
of the Opinion that the said Road should be
established by your honorable body, for the
reason that there is a large Settlement at the
terminus and along the route of said Road
and extensive travel on the same, and that

it will accomodate the people of Eagle Creek
and Grande Ronde Valley. All of which is
