TO THE HONORABLE COUNTY COURT FOR Union COUNTY, OREGON:

The undersigned, householders of Union County, Oregon, residing in the vicinity where the hereinafter described road is proposed to be, respectfully petition your Honorable body to lay out, alter and establish a County road within said County on the following line or route, to-wit:

Commencing on the County road as at present travelled on the Section line between Sections 201 and at a stake at the top of the hill about 15 rods East of the N.W. Corner of Sec 11 72 R 39 E N.M. Thence in a North west direction along the top of the hill about twenty rods, more or less to the Section line between Sections 200, Thence North, the whole width of the road being on the East side of the Section line to the N.W. Corner of N.W. quarter of N.W. quarter of Sec 2 at the old road as at present travelled, and there terminate. And to vacate the road as at present travelled from the N.W. Corner of N.E. quarter of Section 11 72 R 39 E N.M. running thence diagonally across the S.E. 1/4 of N.W. Sec 2 and ending at the top of the hill at the stake at the top of the hill. And in duty bound your petitioners make this prayer, &c.
