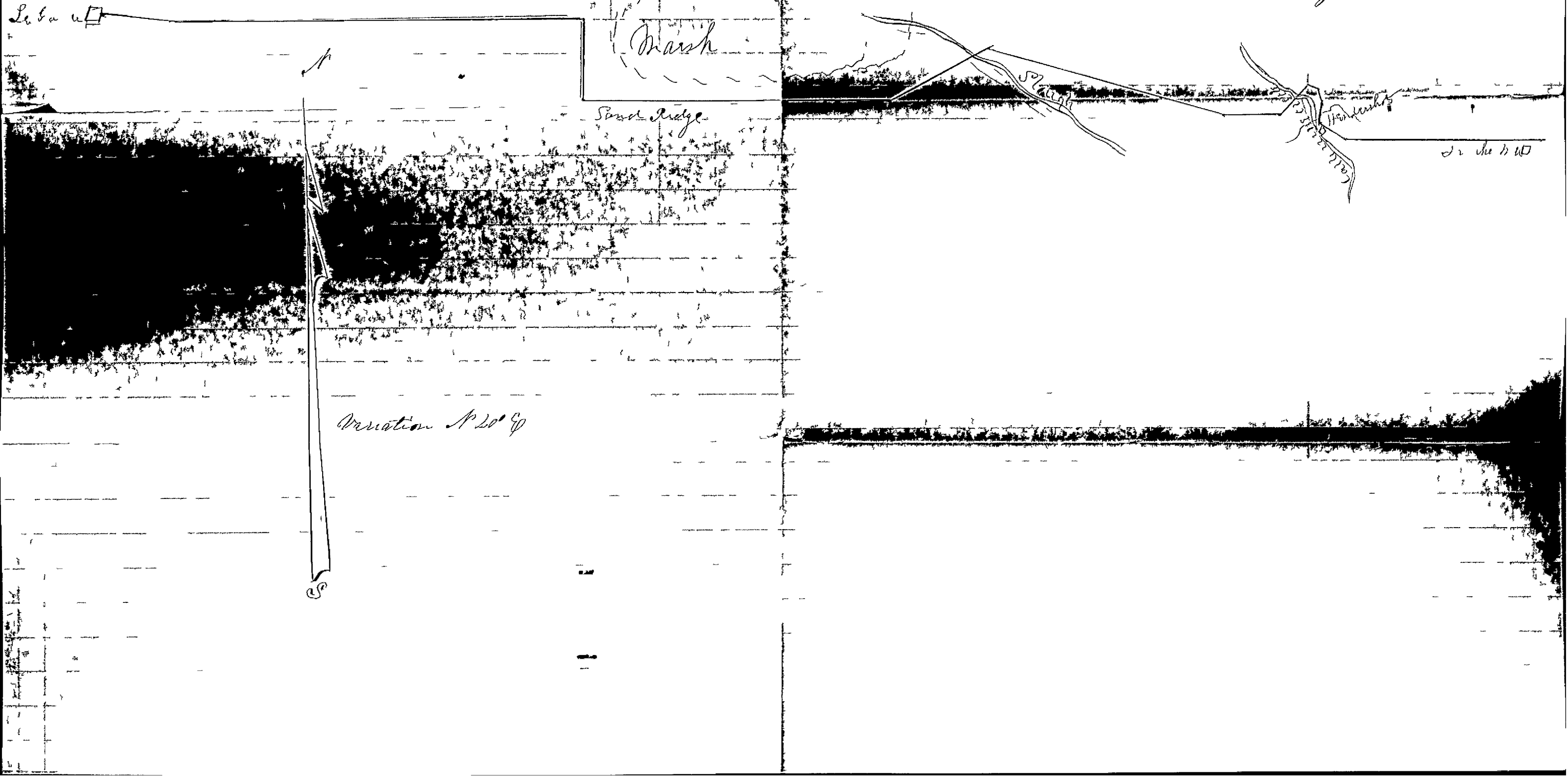

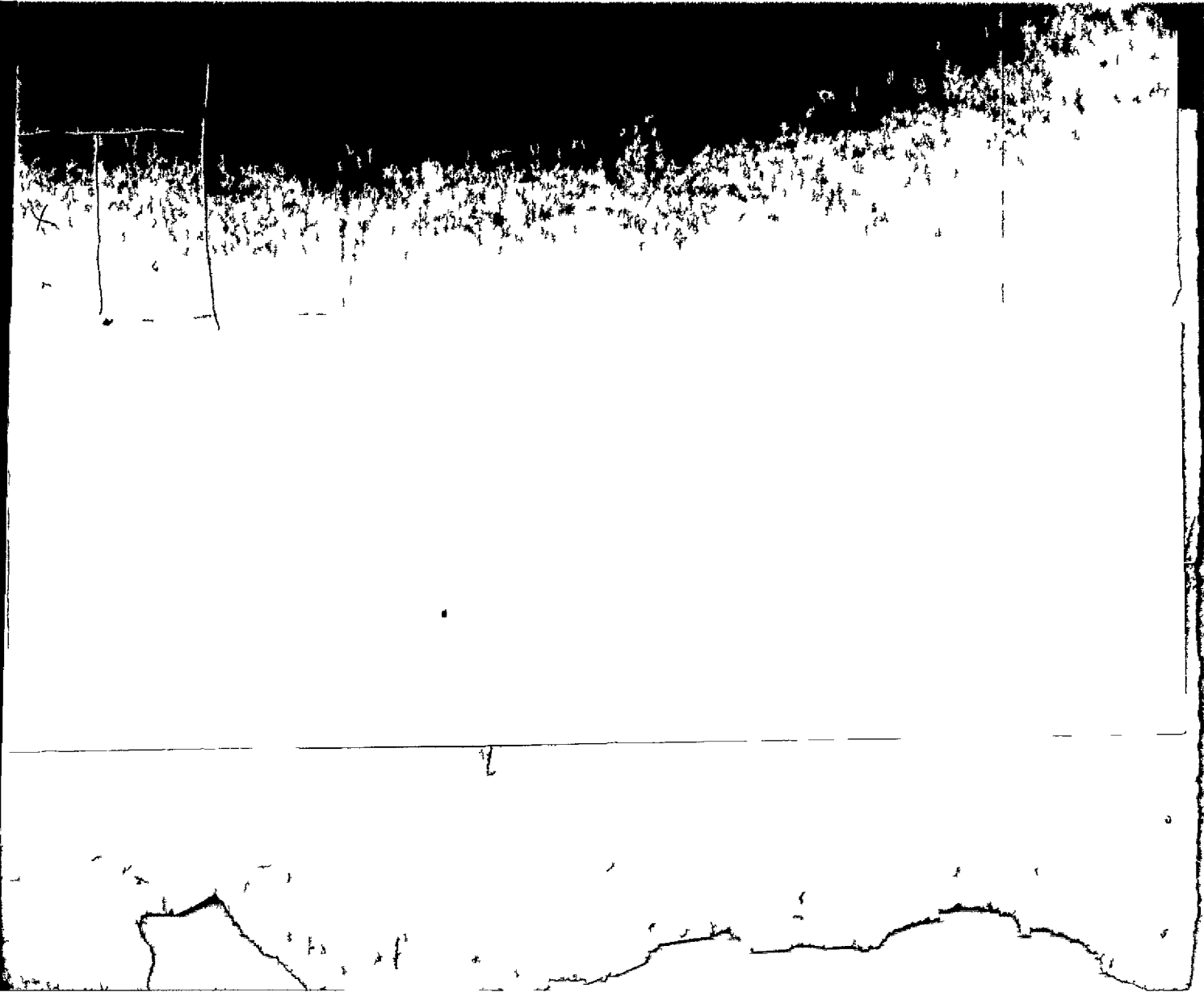

At a regular session of the Board of Commissioners for Union County and State of Oregon begun and held at <sup>(The Court House)</sup> La Grande Union Co & State aforesaid on the 10<sup>th</sup> day of August 1865 Present J. P. Argreinger Esq. Judge & H. L. Thomas Clerk; J. E. Sheriff, and it appearing that the resignation of both the former Commissioners (Sant Payton, & Sant Hannah) had been filed with the Clerk. It is therefore ordered by the Court, that Messrs George Wright Esq. & H. L. Thomas be appointed to fill the vacancies, (whereupon said Geo. Wright, and H. L. Thomas, were duly qualified and the Board proceeded to transact the following business; to wit;

Liquor License

Chas. Bassett & John Harlow having filed their bonds, notices, & petitions, praying for a renewal of their license to sell Spirituous Liquors in less quantities than one quart & which being supported by the proper affidavits as required by law their prayer was granted, and the Clerk ordered to issue license to said parties upon receipt of the money from the Treasurer.

Petition for a County road from Forest Cove to a point on Burnt River presented by S. G. French, was read but not considered practicable by the Board.

Also a petition for a County <sup>road</sup> running from Wellis on Grande Ronde River on the most practicable route to intersect the Co Road running from La Grande to Forest Cove corner, at a point at or near the S. W. corner of Sec. 16 Township 3 S. Range 40 E - which said petition was laid on the table for further consideration at next term.

The resignation of Sant G. French as Road Supervisor for dist. No 8 having been accepted it was ordered by the Board that John Stafford be appointed to fill the vacancy.

Be it remembered that on this 6<sup>th</sup> day of September A. D. 1865 at a regular term of the Commissioners Court held at the Court House in La Grande Union County and State of Oregon Present J. P. Argyring Judge, J. C. Cur Sheriff & J. L. Thomas Clerk the following proceedings were had, to wit;

J. R. Ellison School Superintendent presented his annual report which was approved by the Board & placed on file.  
 By order of the Board the Resignation of Mr. Ellison was accepted and P. C. Shupe was appointed as his successor.

Petition from the Citizens of Post Cove for a Co. Road running from Wells in Grand Ronde Valley to intersect the Road <sup>improving</sup> from La Grande to the Cove & which was laid over at last term was taken up & Granted and C. W. Wells, Saml Chaplin and Mack B. Rives were appointed viewers, with S. Chaplin for Surveyor Viewers to meet on the 22<sup>nd</sup> of Sept.

The viewers appointed at the April term to view Road petitioned for at that term running from N. W. Corner of Section four in Town 2 S. & Range 38 E. running east from said point to intersect S. Walla Walla Road having failed to report, the following persons were appointed to serve as viewers on said Road & Report at next term. J. S. Kinsey, J. W. Dickey, & Edward Lindsey with Saml Chaplin as Surveyor & Viewers to meet on the 16<sup>th</sup> of Sept.

Thomas Colby was appointed Supervisor of Road District No. 10. Said Office having been vacated by the removal of Wm. Garrettman

Coroner

Chas. Aberly was appointed Coroner until his Successor in office be elected and qualified.

P. Agursinger Judge, Isaiah Gurr Sheriff, George Wright & H. L. Stone Commissioners & S. L. Thomas Clerk.

The following business was then there had to wit:

Jas Mc. Pyle offered written report on the indebtedness of Union to Baker County which was received & placed on file & the Clerk ordered to communicate particulars to Commissioners of Baker County.

Application was made to the Board by Jas Mc Pyle, Esq. & W. C. Thomas, and R. S. McCoy for a License to sell Spirituous Liquors in less quantities than one quart all of which said petitions were granted by the Board

Time for viewing Wellsis Road running through Forest Cove was extended until October 14<sup>th</sup> 1865

Michigan Baker was appointed Supervisor for District No 10 said office being vacant by the failure of Thos Lett (appointed at last term) to qualify & refusing to accept said office.

The office of Supervisor of Road District No 3 being vacated by E. C. Kerane (the former incumbent) Edward Lindsey was appointed to said office

Isaiah Gurr having complied with the law regulating Liquor licenses by petitioning for such notice &c a license was granted by order of the Board. It was <sup>first time</sup> ordered by the Board that all bids for building jail must be confined to the specifications furnished by J. W. Sargent and said bids or proposals must be in by the next regular term of the Board in Nov.

Wm. Oberley as coroner and P. S. Shupe School Supt. executed their respective Bonds as required by law which were approved & filed by Clerk on the 13<sup>th</sup> day

It was further ordered by the Board that John McDonald <sup>be</sup> appointed to act as supervisor of Road District No 4, in place of J D Riechert removed from the County.

It is further ordered that there be added to Road District Number Two (2) from the north <sup>of traps bonds river</sup> to the south line of Sec 22, running East & West in Township Number Two (2) South of R Number 38, East.

There being no further Business before the Board, Court then adjourned for the Term.
