We therefore recommend that said proposed road be laid out and declared a public highway of said county.

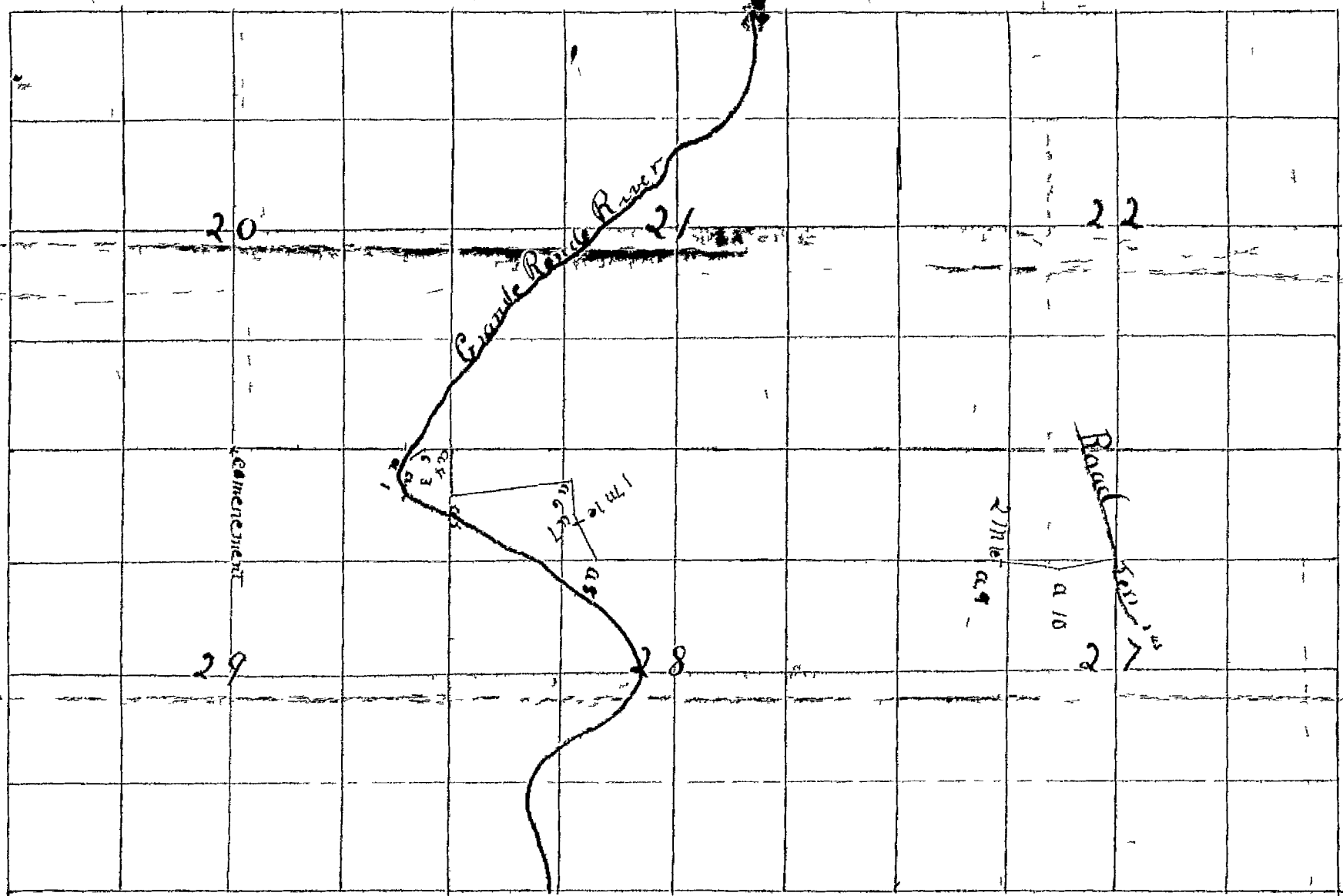
