The undersigned householders of Union County, Oregon, residing in the vicinity where the hereinafter described road is to be, respectfully petition your Honorable body to lay out, alter and establish a County Road within said County, on the following line or route, to-wit:

Beginning at a Stake on County Road near the South line of the N. W. quarter of Sec 21 Town 2 Range 39 Running North to center line of Sec 9, thence N. E. to a Stake at the intersection of County Road in Sec 35 Town 3 passing the home of Albert Lewis in Sec 9 and the home of N. W. Beach in Sec 3. Also a branch road beginning at a Stake at the South line of Sec 16 where above petitioned road crosses said line, running East to the center line of Sec 15 North 1/2 mile, East 1/2 mile, North 1/2 mile to the N. E. corner of Sec 18 Town 2 Range 39. and to discontinue the County Road from beginning of above petitioned road to terminus of branch road except such portions of branch road as are included in this petition.
