In the matter of an allowance to Mrs M. C. Raney.

This matter came on to be heard at this time on the application of Mrs M. C. Raney for an allowance from the County Treasury of this County, and it appearing to the Court from the affidavit of said applicant heretofore filed herein ^{and} the representations now made in her behalf that she is destitute ^{and} unable to earn a living; that she has six helpless children; that she is sick ^{and} cannot work; that she has no relatives or friends living in the State of Oregon who are able or willing to help her, ^{and} that she is a resident of Union County, Oregon, having lived here two years. And it further appearing to the Court that it is fit ^{and} proper that an allowance should be made to said applicant out of the County Treasury of this County, It is therefore considered ^{and} ordered by the Court that the said Mrs M. C. Raney, be ^{and} she is hereby granted an allowance of \$100 per month out of the general fund of this County, ^{and} the Clerk of this Court is hereby authorized ^{and} directed to issue a warrant at the beginning of each month in favor of Mrs M.
