At a term of the County Court of the State of Oregon for the County of Union began and held at the Court House in Salinas Oregon pursuant to adjournment on the 13th day of May A.D. 1874

There was present Hon. C. C. Brainerd County Judge John A. Childers and J. W. Kennedy County Commissioners, Arthur Warrick Sheriff and S. M. Black County Clerk.

Due proclamation of the Opening of Court having been made the following proceedings were had.

In the Matter of Road &
Petition from N. Baker vs 3

Now at this time was presented a petition praying for a County road to be located commencing at the South West Corner of N. Baker's Farm, running thence due East one half mile, thence South one fourth mile, thence East twenty rods, thence South forty rods, thence East forty rods, thence South eighty rods, thence East eighty rods to where it intersects the County road. Which petition was signed by twelve resident householders of Union County living in the vicinity and along the route of said proposed road, which petition was accompanied with a Bond which Bond was duly approved by the Court, as well as by proof of notices having been posted as by law required for more than thirty days prior to this time.

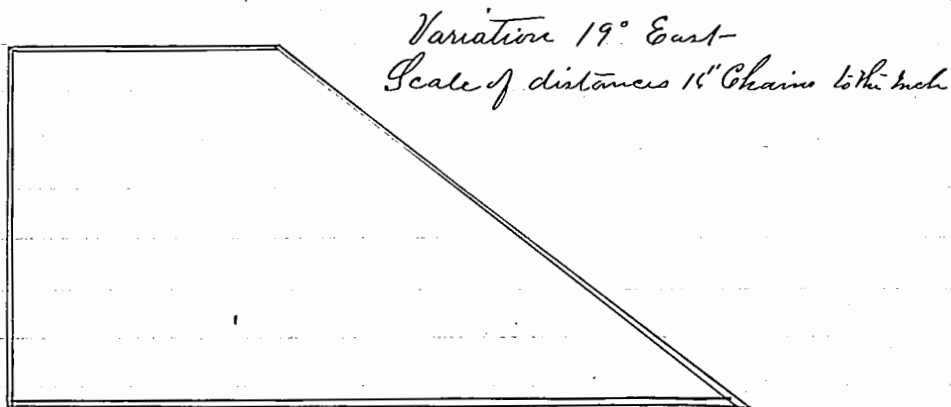
Thereupon it was Ordered that James Mitchell D. Chandler and David Powell be and they are hereby appointed Viewers.

and Willis Skiff Surveyor, who are to meet at the House of S J Booths on the 23rd day of May 1874 and after being sworn as by law required to proceed to view and mark said route, and report their proceedings at the next term of this Court,

In the Matter of Road 2
Petition for County Road 3

Now at this time was presented a petition praying for a County Road to be located commencing at the north end of the lane to G Gray house, thence south or to follow till it strikes G Mitchells line thence West to the corner of Wilhelms field, thence S W to the Bridge on Grand Ronde river, thence on the most practicable route till it strikes the line between M Jasper and G Wilhelm, thence South to J Brissons S E Corner, thence on the Section line running west to the ditch, through said ditch 15 rods to intersect the County Road running from Oro Dell to the Old Road that runs from Mitchells Bridge to Sumnerville all of which points and places are in Union County Oregon, which petition was signed by more than twelve resident householders of Union County residing in the vicinity and along the route of said proposed road, which petition was accompanied by a bond which bond was approved by the Court as well as by proof that notices had been posted in accordance with law more than thirty days prior to this time

It is therefore Ordered that A J Harris, Joseph Harris and S Wright be and are hereby appointed viewers and Willis Skiff Surveyor, who are to meet on the 22nd day of May 1874, ^{at G Gray house} and after being duly sworn as by law required proceed to view out.

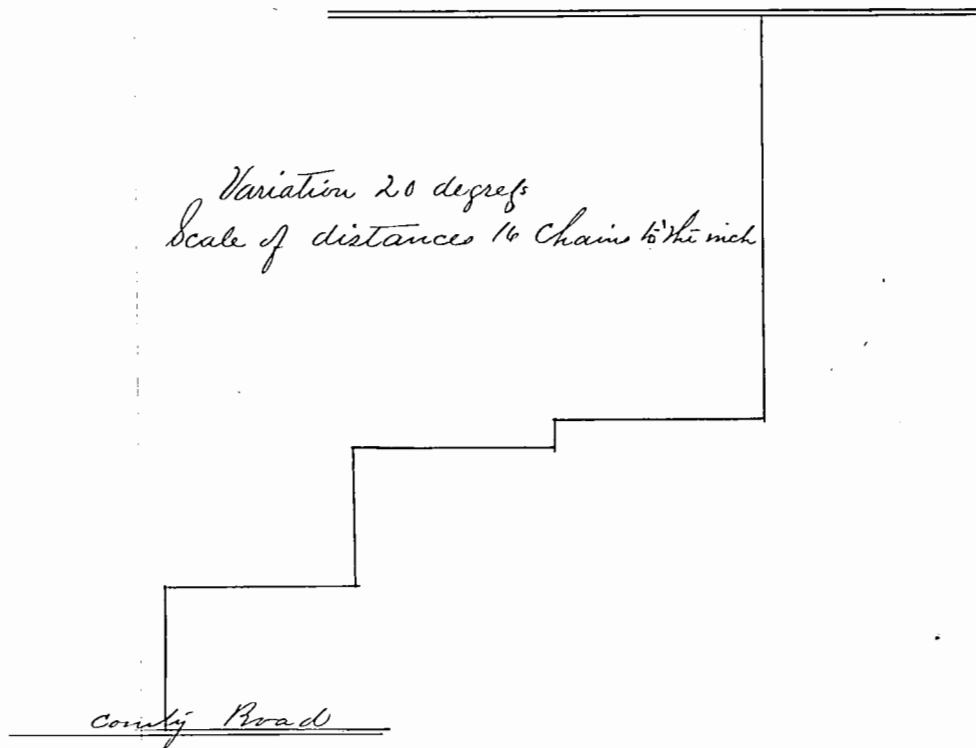

Now at
 this time the report of the viewers to view out
 a road commencing at the S.W. Corner of
 N. Baker's place and running south easterly
 to intersect the County Road was read a second
 time and said road being reported favorable
 and there being no remonstrance or petition for damages
 filed. It is ordered that the prayer of the
 petitioners be granted, and that the same be
 declared a public highway, in accordance to
 the plat and field notes hereinafter placed,
 and it is further ordered that the clerk notify
 the proper Supervisor of these proceedings
 All the above named points are in Union County Ore
