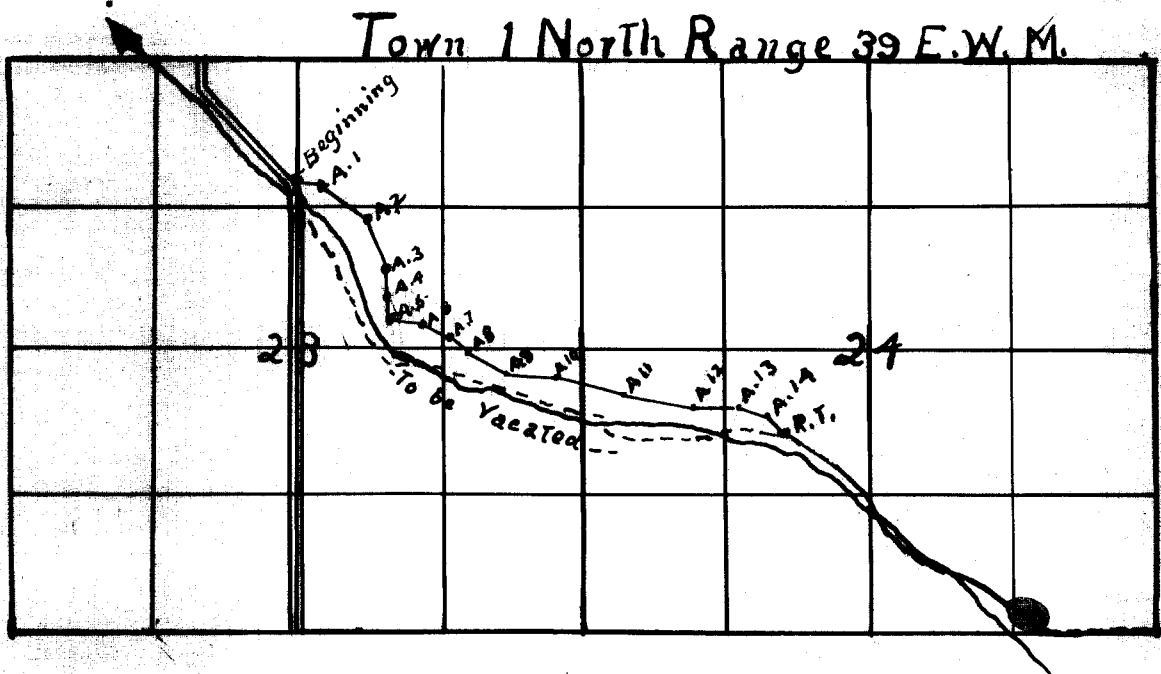

Now at this time this matter came on to be heard on the Report of the Board of County Road Viewers for a first reading as provided by law. And said report having now been read in open Court the same is laid over for a second reading upon another day of this term of Court.

Thereupon it was ORDERED that Court be now adjourned until tomorrow, June 2nd, 1910, at 9 o'clock A.M.

It is therefore CONSIDERED and ORDERED that said petition be granted.

In the Matter of the Cancellation
of Contingent Warrant No. 1746.

Now at this time is presented to the Court for cancellation by the County Clerk Contingent Warrant No. 1746, and it appearing to the Court that said warrant has been erroneously drawn and should be cancelled,

It is therefore CONSIDERED and ORDERED that said warrant be, and the same is here now cancelled and the Clerk is hereby directed to enter the cancellation of said warrant upon his records.

In the Matter of the Proposed
County Road Petitioned for by
S.L. Burnaugh et al.

This matter came to be heard at this time on the report of the Board of County Road Viewers for a second reading, as provided by law, said report being in words following, to-wit:

REPORT OF BOARD OF COUNTY ROAD VIEWERS.

TO THE HONORABLE COUNTY COURT OF UNION COUNTY, OREGON:

The undersigned Board of County Road Viewers heretofore on the 4th day of May, 1910, instructed to view, lay out and alter the proposed county road, of which the survey hereto attached is a true and correct description, as petitioned for by S. L. Burnaugh et al., beg leave to report that on the 16 day of May, 1910, in pursuance with said order, we proceeded to view out said proposed road for the whole distance

It is therefore CONSIDERED and ORDERED that the Clerk of this Court be, and he is hereby directed to draw a warrant on the General Fund of the County in favor of said Mrs. F. B. Huntley for the sum of \$25.00.

In the Matter of the Proposed County Road petitioned for by S.L. Burnaugh et al.

It appearing to the court at this time that the opening of the above entitled road will occasion expensive rock and other work, and that it would be more economical to contract a part of said rock work,

It is, therefore, ORDERED that Arthur Curtis, County Surveyor be, and he is hereby directed to survey out said road and estimate the amount of rock work necessary to complete said road and that he file such estimate with the County Clerk, and it is further ORDERED that the County Clerk advertise for bids for said road work in the Elgin Recorder in accordance with the plans and estimate filed by the County Surveyor as above directed.

In the Matter of the Proposed County Road petitioned for by A. C. Spain et al.

Comes now A. C. Spain, one of the petitioners for the above named proposed County Road, and presents to the Court the petition of himself and others, praying for the location and establishment of a county road described as follows, to-wit:
