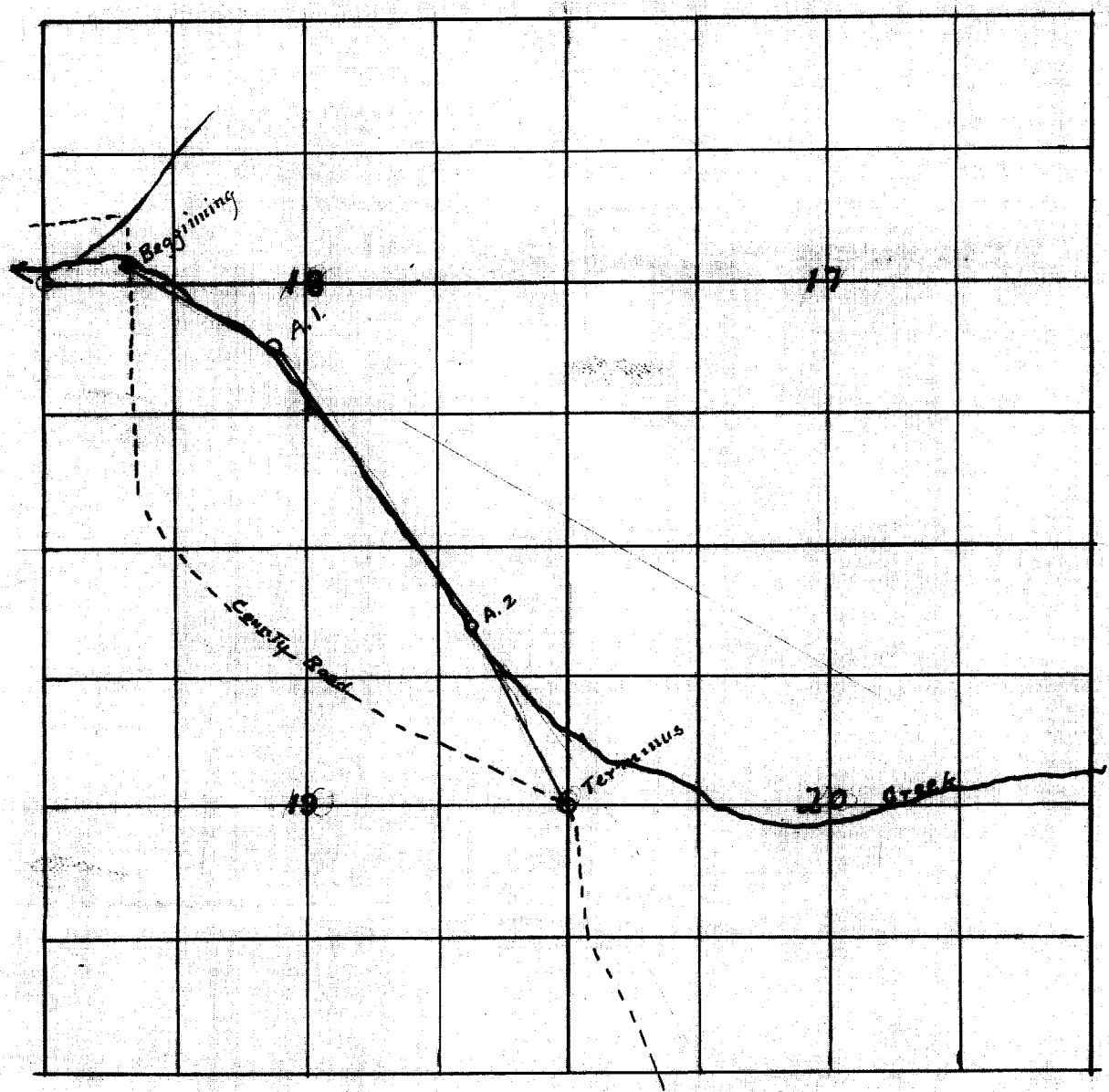

And said report of the Board of County Road Viewers having been now publicly read in open court on two several days of a previous term of the Court, and it appearing to the court that said Board of County Road Viewers report favorable thereon, and recommend that said proposed road be established as a county road and be declared a public highway of Union County, Oregon, and all the proceedings herein having been regular and according to law, and the claim for damages filed herein being here now disallowed, and there having been no cause shown why this proposed road should not be declared a public highway and ordered open according to law, and the court being satisfied from the report of the Board of County Road Viewers that such road will be of public utility; the report of the viewers being favorable thereto, and all the files and records of said proceedings having been submitted to the District Attorney, who has advised this court as to the legality of said proceedings,
