At a term of the County Court of Union County Oregon, begun and held at the Court house in Union on the 9<sup>th</sup> day of Sept A.D. 1874 there was present Hon E. C. Brainerd County Judge. E. J. Neville & Jessie Imbler, Co Commissioners J. L. Curtis, Sheriff R. S. Bates, Co Clerk.

Due proclamation of the opening of Court having been made, the following proceedings were had.

Now at this time was presented a petition praying for a County Road commencing at the center of section 8 of Township one Range 39 East, running thence 2 miles south, thence West  $\frac{1}{4}$  mile thence South  $\frac{1}{2}$  half mile, intersecting a County road at the last named point all of which places and points are in Union Co Oregon, which petition was signed by more than twelve resident householders residing in the vicinity of the Road and along the route of said road which petition was accompanied by a bond as required by law, which Bond was duly approved by the Court as well as by proof of the posting four notices in accordance with the law more than thirty days prior to the meeting of this Court. It is therefore ordered that John Binchart, J. Harris & Wm German be and they are hereby appointed Viewers, and Willis Skiff Surveyor who are to meet at the house of P. L. Courtney, Sept. 26<sup>th</sup> 1874 and after being duly sworn as by law required proceed to view out said Road and report their <sup>doing</sup> at the next term of this Court.

Friday Nov 27<sup>th</sup> 1874.

Court met pursuant to adjournment. There was present Hon E. C. Brainard Judge. E. S. Krille & Jessie Smbler County Commissioners, J. L. Curtis Sheriff, and R. D. Bates County Clerk.

On Proclamation of the opening of Court having been made the following proceedings were had.

In the matter of }

Now at this time was presented the report of the viewers appointed to view out a road commencing at the center of Sec 8 of Township one Range 39 East running thence 2 miles South, thence west 1/4 mile, thence South 1/2 mile, intersecting a county road at the last named point. Which report was publicly read in Court on two different days of the same meeting the viewers thereof reporting favorably, a petition for damages being also presented by McRae Colin McRae, asking damages to the amount of one thousand dollars

After careful consideration by the Court it is therefore ordered and decreed that Joel Weaver, James Stanley, & Robert Buckman be and they are hereby appointed viewers to proceed and view said proposed Road the whole distance through the premises of the Complainant, and assess and determine how much less valuable such premises of the complainant would be rendered by the opening of said road, and report the same in writing to this Court at the next regular term, First Monday in January 1875. And it is further ordered



that said viewers meet on the 5<sup>th</sup> day of December 1874. at the house of Jesser Imbler to view said road. And it is ordered that the Co Clerk furnish a copy of this Record to each of the viewers.

In the matter of

Now at this time it is Ordered that J. L. Curtis Sheriff of Union County be empowered and he is hereby authorized, made and Constituted the Agent of this Court to procure food, lodgings and medical attendance for the County poor of this County from this date until the next regular term thereof to be held on the first Monday of January 1875

No further business appearing the Court adjourned until tomorrow morning at 9 O'clock. A.M.

Third judicial day Nov 25<sup>th</sup> 1874  
 Court met pursuant to adjournment. Same Officers present as of yesterday

Due proclamation of the opening of Court having been made the following proceedings were had

Ordered adjudged and decreed by the Court that: W.W. Sharp be and he is hereby appointed a Justice of the Peace for Summerville Precinct Union Co Oregon. and the Term of his Office shall commence as soon as he shall file bonds to be approved by the Court with his Oath of Office endorsed thereon as by law required.

In the matter of receiving }  
 Viewers report. Granting }  
 County Road }

Now at this time was presented the Report of R. D. Ruckman and J. H. Standley, viewers heretofore appointed to view out and assess damages prayed for by Collin McRae upon a Road commencing at the center of Sec 8 Town one Range 39 East and running  $2\frac{1}{4}$  miles South thence West  $\frac{1}{4}$  mile, thence South  $\frac{1}{2}$  mile intersecting a County Road. and the said viewers have assessed damages in favor of said Collin McRae to the amount of Seventy five Dollars And now at this same time appears the said Collin McRae and in open Court, relinquishing all claims for damages and all charges to the said Seventy five Dollars.

Whereupon, after due consideration it is Ordered by the Court and decreed that the petition heretofore entered upon the Journal of the Court be granted and that said Road is now declared a Public Highway
