In the matter of Petition for
County Road from H Rinehart to Mrs Kennedy's
Appointing Viewers

Now at this time was presented a petition
praying for a County Road from or Commencing
at the North East Corner of Henry Rinehart
plantation and running on the practicable
route - (So as not to create damage to any plantation)
to the house of Joseph Harris. thence due south
to the house of Mrs Kennedy so as to intersect
a County Road leading from said Kennedy's
to the Cove, all of which points are in Union
County Oregon, which petition ^{was} accompanied by a bond
which bond was duly approved by the Court, also
proof of Notices having been posted according
to law in such cases.

and the petition being signed by more than
twelve resident-householders along & in the
vicinity of said Road. It is therefore Ordered
that Jacob Long J. B. Courtney and J. Graham
be and they are hereby appointed viewers and
Willis Skiff Surveyor who are to meet at the
House of Mrs Smith in Indian Valley on Jan 22nd
1875 & after being duly sworn as by law required
to proceed and view & mark said Road and
report their proceedings at the next term of
this Court

In the matter of Road

Now on this day was
presented a petition praying for a County Road
commencing at or near the farm of Mrs A. Smith
on the road leading from Clarks Creek to the

In the matter of Appointment
of Supervisor of Road District No 1.

Now on this day
it was ordered that E. O. Grandall be and
he is hereby appointed Supervisor of Roads
in Road Dist No 1. in place of E. W. Cook
resigned

In the matter of
Road viewers Report

Now on this siday it appearing
to the Court that viewers were appointed at
the January Term of this Court 1875. to view
out a county road commencing at the north
east corner of Henry Pineharts plantation and
running on the most practible rout to
the house of Joseph Harris. thence due
south to the house of Wm Kennedy so as to
intersect a county road leading from said
Kennedys to the Cove

Also at the same time the same persons were
appointed to view out and report on the follow-
ing proposed road to wit:

Commencing at or near the farm of Wm A Smith
on the road leading from Clarke creek to the
Willowa River and running on the same
until it comes to the land of Robert Knights
on Clarke creek. then following up the east
side of said creek to a stake marked 45
thence due west to a stake marked 46
thence south west on the most practible
rout to the line dividing the lands of W
A Stevenson and Joshua Weaver, designated
by a stake marked 47 following said line
west to the road leading from the Indian
creek School house to William Gordons. thence
on the most practible rout to the east
line of E B Morelocks Plantation

designated by a stake marked 48. thence south on said line to the line dividing the lands of E. B. Morelock and Henry Rinchart. thence west on said line to the second crossing of Grand Round River thence on the west bank of said River to a stake marked 49. thence west to intersect the county road leading from Summerville to Indian Valley.

And it further appearing that they failed to make their report at the March Term as directed, and that they were subsequently reappointed to wit: on the 3rd day of March to view out said roads and present their reports to the April term to have been held, and it further appearing that they could not view proposed roads on account of the inclemency of the weather: It is therefore Ordered that they: Jacob Long: T. B. Courtney and J. Grayham. the viewers heretofore appointed, be and they are hereby reappointed to meet at the house of Wm Smith in Indian Valley on Monday the 21st day of June and after being duly sworn, proceed, with Willis Skiff as Surveyor, to view out said proposed Roads and report their doings at the July Term of this Court.

In the matter of
Road Viewers

Now on this day it appearing that viewers were appointed at the March term of this Court. to view out a County Road from Summerville to H. W. Olivers Saw Mill $2\frac{1}{2}$ miles north of Summerville. thence to the Summerville

In the matter of
Viewers Report.

Now on this day was presented the viewers report of the viewers appointed to view out and report on a county road commencing at the North east corner of Henry Rineharts farm thence to intersect the county road near the house of Wm Kennedy's which report was read a second time having been read yesterday which report was accompanied by the plat of the survey, and it appearing that the petitioners have proceeded according to law and the being no remonstrance or petition for damages It was ordered the road petitioned for be granted and the same be declared a public highway, as the viewers reported favorable.
