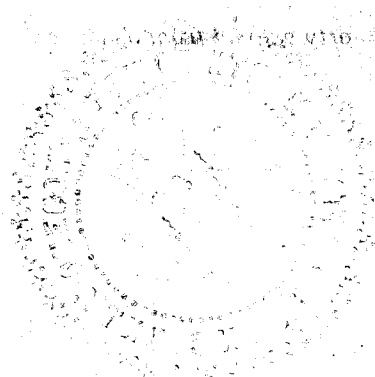

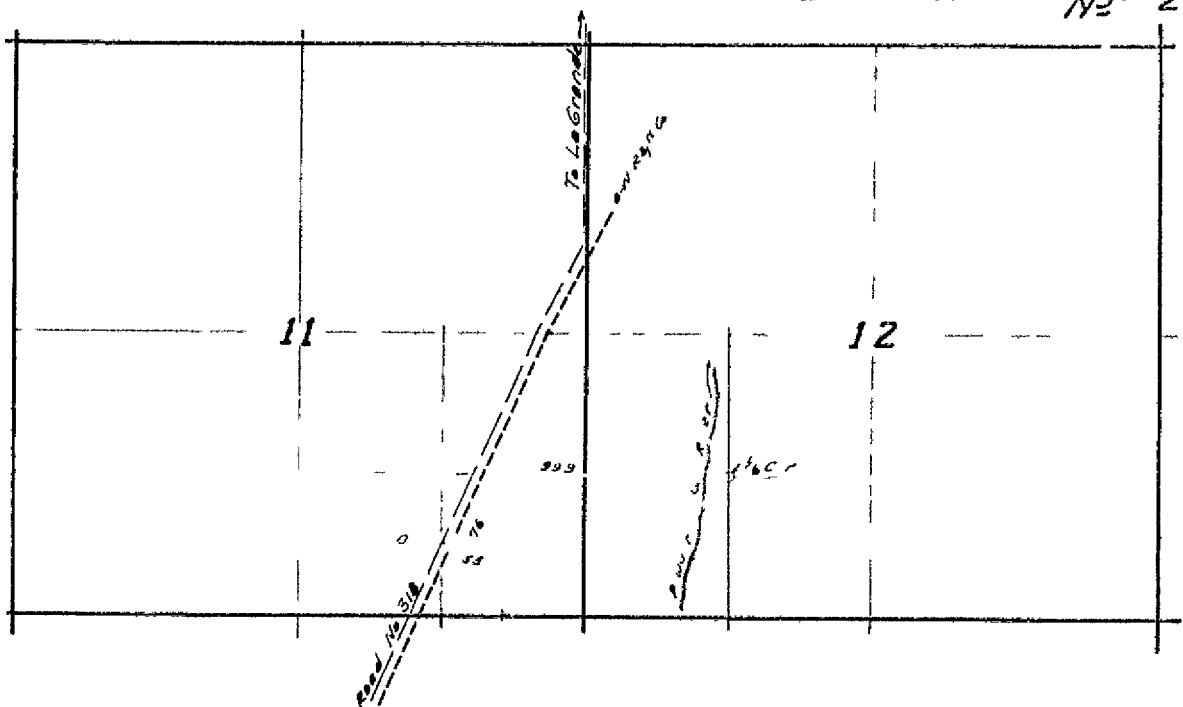
REPORT OF BOARD OF COUNTY ROAD VIEWERS.

Now at this time it is ORDERED that this application be and the same is hereby allowed, and the Sheriff is hereby directed and authorized to cancel the last half of the taxes for the year 1916 assessed against a certain stock of goods in the possession of Tony D. Smith of Union Oregon, and that he take proper credit therefor.

direction along the east bank of Catherine creek about one-fourth mile to intersect the County road from Union to Hot Lake (known as the Valley road) at a point about thirty feet east of the east bank of Catherine creek at or near the east end of the Jolley bridge; the said Jolley bridge being at or near the quarter section corner on the south boundary line of Sec. 3, Tp. 4 S. Rge 39 EWM, there to terminate.

And it appearing to the Court that said petition is signed by more than twelve freeholders of this county, residing in the road district where the hereinbefore described road is proposed to be, and that said petition properly specifies the place of beginning, intermediate points and place of termination of said road, and it satisfactorily appearing to the court that notice has been given by advertisement posted at the place of holding County Court, to-wit: at the Court House in the city of La Grande, Union County, Oregon, and also in three public places in the vicinity of said proposed road, to-wit: one on the School House at the beginning of the road; one on the Jolley bridge near the terminus of said road, and one on a stake driven near the center of said road, for more than thirty days immediately prior to the presentation of said petition to this court, notifying all persons concerned that application would be made to this court, at the present session of this court, and that the notices so posted were in due form and duly signed by the petitioners, and that a bond for the cost of this proceeding has been duly given.
