TO THE HONORABLE COUNTY COURT FOR UNION COUNTY, OREGON:

The undersigned Board of County Road Viewers, heretofore on the 10th. day of May, 1919, instructed to view, lay out and alter the proposed county road, of which the survey hereto attached is a true and correct description, as petitioned for by M. O. Combs et al., beg leave to report that on the 23rd. day of May, 1919, in pursuance with said order, we proceeded to view out said proposed road for the whole distance thereof, and that in our opinions said proposed road should be laid out and established as a public highway of Union County, Oregon; that the same is practicable and would add greatly to the convenience of the householders residing in the vicinity thereof. We therefore recommend that said proposed road be laid out and declared a public highway of said county, and that said road is a public necessity, and we recommend that damages be awarded as follows, Barnett--\$10.00, Combs--\$10.00, Ghuna--\$25.00, and that the line of the road be altered for a distance of 300 feet after leaving the East Bank of the Grande Ronde River so as to miss the rock cliff which would be encountered when following the description as indicated in the original petition. This road should be opened as soon as possible to permit the passage of stock now being driven to the summer range.

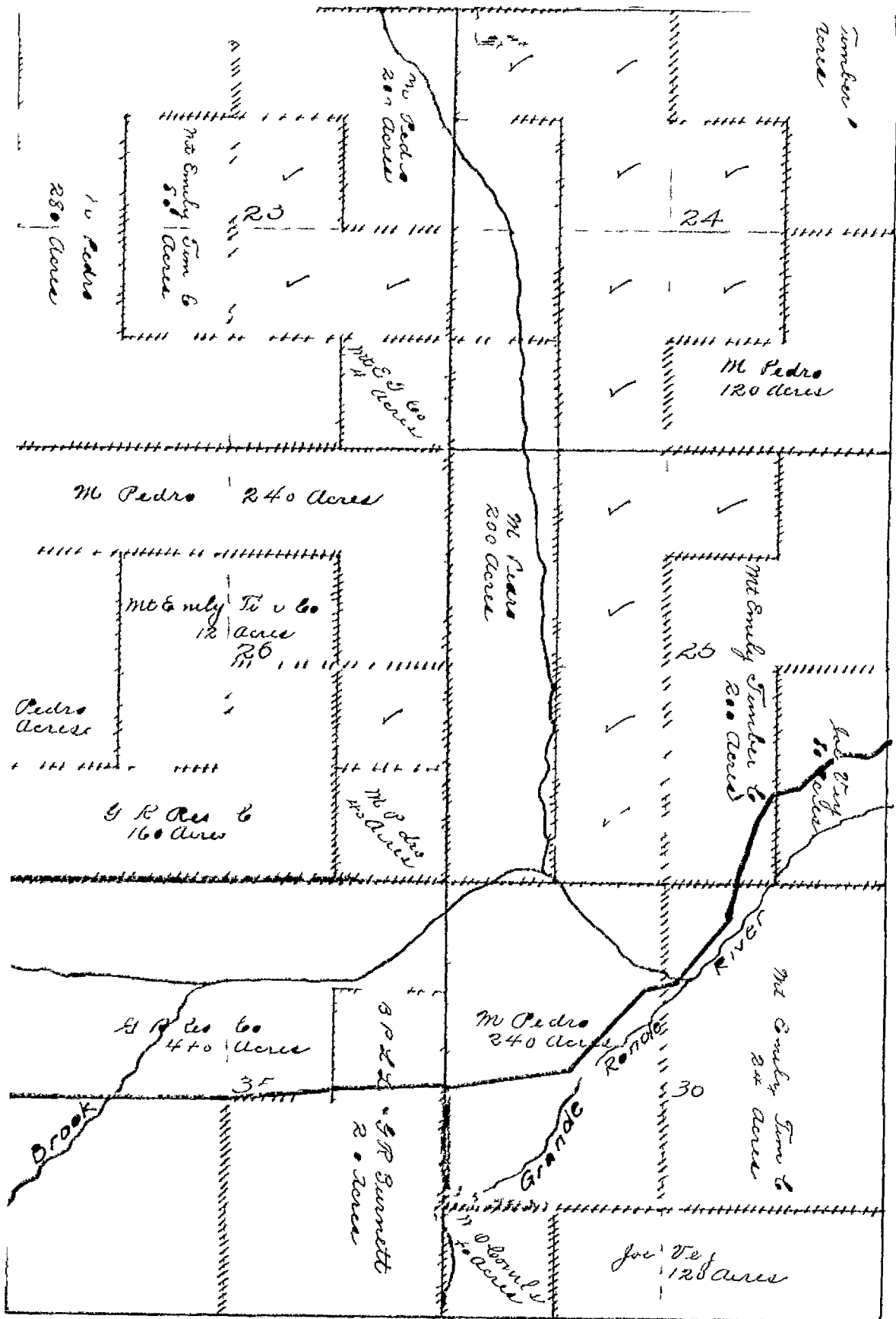
