In the matter of the proposed County Road petitioned for by D. B. Stoddard, et al.

Now at this time, it is ORDERED that the above entitled matter be and the same is hereby continued for the term.

In the matter of Contracting for the Completion of the Victory Way.

Now at this time, it is ORDERED that the County Judge be and he is hereby authorized to solicit bids for the grading of the Victory Way and to enter into an agreement with the lowest responsible bidder provided a satisfactory bid is received.

In the matter of re-wiring the Court House.

Now at this time, it appearing that on September 12th, 1922, this Court accepted the bid of the Milne Electric Company of La Grande, Oregon, for the re-wiring of the County Court House conditioned upon the filing of a satisfactory bond by the said Milne Electric Company, and it further appearing that the said company has failed to file a bond,

It is CONSIDERED AND ORDERED that the bid of the H & S Electric Company be accepted conditioned upon the filing by said Company of a satisfactory bond in the sum of \$575.00, said company being the second lowest bidder.

Thereupon the Journal of today's proceedings was read, approved, and is here now signed, and it was ORDERED that Court be now adjourned for the term.

It is therefore CONSIDERED AND ORDERED that said petition be and the same is hereby denied and dismissed.

In the matter of the resignation  
of D. J. McLellan as County  
Surveyor.

Now at this time is presented to the Court the resignation of D. J. McLellan as County Surveyor of Union County and it appearing to the Court that the said D. J. McLellan has removed from Union County and can no longer perform the duties of said office

It is CONSIDERED AND ORDERED that said resignation be accepted and that same become effective at once.

In the matter of the acceptance  
of the deeds of C. J. Pratt and  
wife to a right-of-way for the  
La Grande-Joseph Highway.

Now at this time is presented to the Court the deeds of C. J. Pratt and wife to a right-of-way for the La Grande-Joseph Highway across lands owned by them in the Northwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) Section 20, Tp 1 SR 39 E.W.M. in Union County, also across lands owned by them in lot 8 of the Bridges and Cleaver orchard tract in the Southeast Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section 17, Tp 1 SR 39 E.W.M., in Union County, and it appearing to the Court that it is necessary for Union County to acquire the lands described in the deeds,

It is CONSIDERED AND ORDERED that said deeds be accepted and the County Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to draw a warrant on the Road Bond Fund of the County in favor of said C. J. Pratt in the sum of \$452.00 in payment for said deeds in the sums of \$400.00 and \$52.00 respectively.

In the matter of the application  
of William Wiggins for the issuance  
of a new warrant in lieu of  
a lost warrant.

Now at this time this matter comes on to be heard upon the petition of William Wiggins for the issuance of a new warrant in lieu of warrant No. 692, series 1922, drawn on the General Road Fund for the sum of \$39.75, said warrant having been accidentally burned by the said William Wiggins and it appearing to the Court that said application should be allowed,

It is therefore CONSIDERED AND ORDERED that the County Clerk be and he is hereby authorized and directed to draw a warrant on the General Road Fund in the sum of \$39.75 in favor of the said William Wiggins in lieu of the warrant destroyed, upon the filing of an indemnity bond in the sum of \$79.50 by the said William Wiggins.
