To the Honorable County Court, Union County, Oregon:

For the Partial Vacation of Road No. 615  
between Sections 17 & 18 T 2S R38 EWM.

I beg leave to report that on the 7th day of June, 1935, in pursuance with said order I proceeded to view out that portion of Road No. 615, being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the one-quarter (1/4) corner between Sections 17 & 18 T 2S R38 EWM, thence south along the section line a distance of 660 feet, which point is the terminus of the road, to be vacated.

The land owners and a description of their property which borders on this road are as follows:

Property of A. N. Mayville, the southeast one-quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section 18 T 2S R38 EWM.

Property of W. T. Grider, the south one-half of the south one-half of the southeast one-quarter of the northeast one-quarter of Section 18 and the northwest one-quarter of the northwest one-quarter of the northwest one-quarter of the southwest one-quarter of Section 17 (S $\frac{1}{2}$  S $\frac{1}{2}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 18 and NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 17) T 2S R38 EWM.

Property of E. D. Whiting, the west one-half of the northwest one-quarter (W $\frac{1}{2}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section 17 T 2S R38 EWM.

The above described portion of Road No. 615 is a dead end road and adds nothing to the convenience of the land owners in the immediate vicinity. It is burdensome to maintain and the County would be benefited by its vacation.

I therefore recommend that the above described portion of Road No. 615 be closed as a public highway of Union County, Oregon.

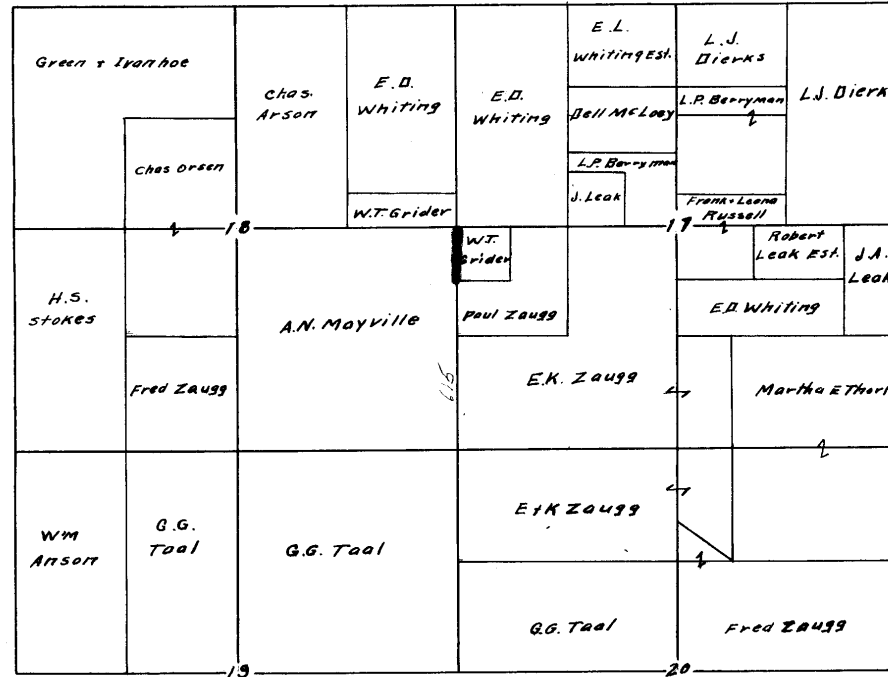
