Darley, being first duly sworn, say, That I am a surveyor and Civil Engineer; that on the 13th day of March, A.D. 1911, I surveyed the lands designated in the accompanying plat, to-wit: Carr's Sub-Division of Blocks 13 and 14 of Honan's Addition to the City of La Grande, Union Co., Oregon; That said survey is correctly made; that the initial point of said plat and survey is at the iron pin at the intersection of the S.W. line of Washington St. and the center line of sixteenth near lot 16, Blk 17 of Concedable Addition to La Grande, Or. and angled from the S.W. line of Washington as outlined by paper as shown on Concedable Add. 139°58' to the south West cor. Lot 11 Blk 1 of this survey and this point is marked with a monument consisting of a galvanized pipe 2" in diameter and 3' long, driven 6 inches below the ground and the same is located with reference to the appraised monuments of Concedable Addition as indicated on the accompanying plat, and that said plat and the survey by which the same was made conforms to Law.
