

Evacuation Notice

5 minute warning

Suggested Items to Gather

- Wallet/purse, emergency cash (small bills), credit card, identification, keys
- Cell phones, laptop, chargers, car charger
- Checkbook, bills
- Hearing aids, medications, glasses, first aid kit
- Baby items if applicable, ie diapers, wipes, formula, etc.
- Change of clothes for current season, shoes
- Flashlights, radio, batteries
- Water, food, blankets/sleeping bags
- Pets and food, leashes, carriers

Evacuation Notice

15 minute warning

Suggested Items to Gather

- Items from **5 minute warning list**
- 3 days clothing
- Comfort items—pillows, books, kids toys
- Valuable personal possessions
- Hygiene items, wash cloth, towel, soap, hand wipes, sanitizer
- Important documents such as insurance policies; contracts, marriage, divorce, death certificates; bank account info; copies of id and social security card
- Addresses and phone contacts.

Ready, Set, Go Evacuation Levels

LEVEL 1: "BE READY"

Potential for evacuation is present. Residents should be aware of the danger, monitor public safety and local media sources for updated information. This is the time for preparation and precautionary movement of persons with special needs, mobile property, and potentially pets and livestock. If conditions worsen, public safety personnel may contact you via emergency notification

LEVEL 2: "BE SET"

You must be prepared to leave at a moments notice. This level indicates there is significant danger in your area. Residents may choose to voluntarily evacuate now to a location outside of the affected area. Residents within a Level 2 "Be Set" notice must be ready to evacuate at a moments notice. Residents will have minimal time to gather necessary items, and doing so is at their own risk. This may be the only notice you receive. Public safety personnel cannot guarantee they will be able to notify you if conditions rapidly deteriorate. Continue to monitor local media sources, social media, and your telephone devices for emergency notifications to receive further information.

LEVEL 3: "GO"

Evacuate NOW, leave immediately! Danger in your area is imminent. If you choose to ignore this notice, you must understand that public safety officials may not be available to assist you further. DO NOT DELAY leaving to gather any belongings or make efforts to protect your home. This may be the last notice you receive until the notice is cancelled or downgraded. Entry into evacuated areas may be denied until conditions are deemed safe by public safety officials. Continue to monitor local media sources, social media, and your telephone devices for emergency notifications to receive further information.

Evacuation Notice

30 minute warning

Suggested Items to Gather

- Items from **5 minute warning list**
- Items from **15 minute warning list**
- Cooler with ice, food, drinks
- 3 days of food, special dietary items
- Genealogy records, licenses, deeds, vehicle titles, files
- Gloves, dust masks
- Paper cups, plates, utensils, paper towels
- School items, homework, pen/pencil, paper, calculator
- Medical records, wills, powers of attorney
- Personal property list, photos, appraisals, documentation

Evacuation Notice

1 hour+ warning

Suggested Items to Gather

- Items from **5 minute warning list**
- Items from **15 minute warning list**
- Items from **30 minute warning list**
- Albums, photos, home videos
- Military decorations, records, mementos
- Luggage (packed)
- Family heirlooms
- Camping equipment
- Fill gas tanks in vehicles
