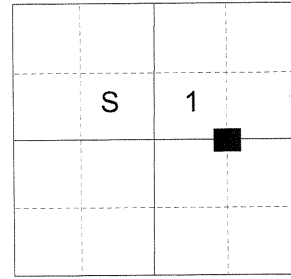

NEW BEARING OBJECTS:

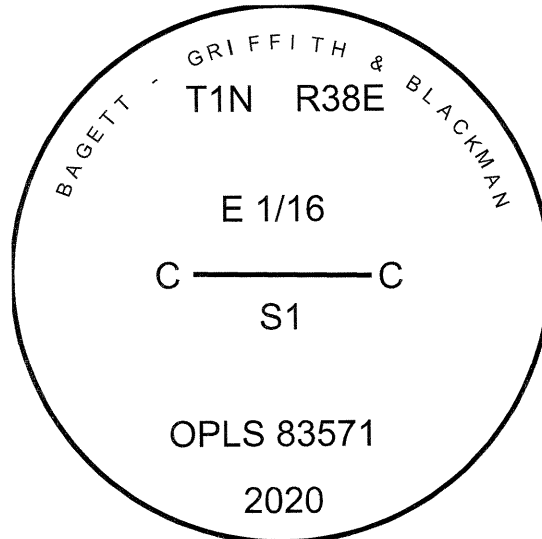
A 5" Douglas Fir bears North 32° West a dist. of 21.90 ft., marked CE 1/16 S1 BT.
A 5" Douglas Fir bears South 71° West a dist. of 7.75 ft., marked CE 1/16 S1 BT.

I used a steel tape and magnetic compass in the establishment of the new accessories. I used 14° East declination, the distances are to a 60d spike driven into the right side of the root crown of the bearing trees. A brass washer marked OPLS 83571 is attached to the BT blaze of the new bearing trees.
