Cooper, 1881 states: Set post, $4 \frac{1}{2} \mathrm{ft}$. long, 4 ins. square, 2 ft . in the ground on E. side of mountain $600^{\prime}$ above valley lying $E$. for cor. to secs. 1,6,7, and 12, marked T1N S6 on NE, R38E S7 on SE, R37E S12 on SW, and S1 on NW with 5 notches $S$ and 1 notch N, from which:

A Fir $10^{\prime \prime}$ diam. bears $S 10^{\circ} \mathrm{E} 98 \mathrm{lks}$. dist, marked TIN R38E S7 BT.

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A Pine $36^{\prime \prime}$ diam. bears $N 27^{\circ} E 144$ lks. dist, marked TIN R38E S6 BT. No other trees in limits, raise mound of stone alongside.
